By letter L-2016-137 dated July 28, 2016 (Agencywide Documents Access and Management System Accession No. ML16214A276), NextEra Energy Resources/Florida Power & Light Company (the licensee) requested license amendments for Duane Arnold Energy Center, Point Beach Units 1 and 2, Seabrook Station, St. Lucie Units 1 and 2, and Turkey Point Nuclear Generating Unit Nos. 3 and 4 (CAC Nos. MF8202-MF8209). In this letter, the licensee also proposed an alternative pursuant to Title 10 of the *Code of Federal Regulations*, Paragraph 50.55a(z) for Point Beach Units 1 and 2, Seabrook Station, St. Lucie Units 1 and 2, and Turkey Point Nuclear Generating Unit Nos. 3 and 4 (CAC Nos. MF8195 – MF8201).

The NRC performed an acceptance review of the application to determine if the scope and depth of technical information is sufficient for the NRC staff to complete its detailed technical review. The acceptance review also intends to identify whether the application has any readily apparent information insufficiencies in its characterization of the regulatory requirements or the licensing bases of the plants.

The NRC staff concluded that the licensee's submittal provides technical information in sufficient detail to enable the NRC staff to complete its detailed technical review and make an independent assessment regarding the acceptability of the proposed request in terms of regulatory requirements and the protection of public health and safety and the environment.

Given the lesser scope and depth of the acceptance review as compared to the detailed technical review, there may be instances in which the NRC staff identifies issues that affect its ability to complete the detailed technical review despite completion of an adequate acceptance review. If the NRC staff needs additional information, it will notify the licensee by separate correspondence.
