**ORDER**

Edlow International Company (Edlow) submitted a motion on August 31, 2016, seeking an extension of time until October 4, 2016, to file an answer to Dr. Alan J. Kuperman's intervention petition on Edlow's application to export highly enriched uranium to the BR-2 research reactor in Belgium. Dr. Kuperman submitted his intervention petition on August 4, 2016. Pursuant to 10 C.F.R. § 110.83(a), Edlow's answer is due by September 6, 2016.

Dr. Kuperman has verbally indicated that he opposes the motion.<sup>1</sup> Dr. Kuperman is granted seven days from the date of this order to respond in writing to Edlow's motion. To enable full consideration of the motion, I am issuing a housekeeping stay until further order.
