Dear Mr. Palmer:

On February 2, 2016, the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) cited Kaiser Foundation Hospital for failure to meet requirements found in Title 10 of the *Code of Federal Regulations* Part 20 (Inspection Report 030-03546/2016-001). On August 11, 2016, you contacted us to let us know you had completed the corrective action associated with the violation (ML16250A839).

After reviewing the information you provided in your response to the Notice of Violation, we have concluded that your completed actions appear to adequately address the regulatory noncompliance described in the Notice of Violation. We will review your implementation of these corrective actions during a future inspection to determine whether full compliance has been restored.
