Dear Dr. Hazlett:

Enclosed is Amendment No. 40 to your NRC Material License No. 13-12367-01 in accordance with your August 10, 2016 request to add a new area of use at your Jeffersonville, Indiana facility. Please note that we have also deleted Condition No. 13 in accordance with current NRC policy to include the reference to Title 10 of the *Code of Federal Regulations*, Part 71, "Packaging and Transportation of Radioactive Material," in the preamble, on page 1 of the license. Note that this amendment does not include the removal of the previously existing area where your gamma camera has been housed. Removal of the old area of use must be requested under separate cover, and include final surveys and disposition information.

Please review the enclosed document carefully and be sure that you understand all conditions. If there are any errors or questions, please notify the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission, Region III office at (630) 829-9887 so that we can provide appropriate corrections and answers.
