Hello Mr. Freeman,

I appreciate the opportunity to comment on the Import/Export amendments being sought by Perma-Fix Northwest, Inc. (PFNW). It is my understanding that PFWN would import Canadian waste contaminated with various radionuclides in varying combinations. PFWN would treat and process the waste and return (export) all waste to the Canadian consignees.

My only comment on these amendments revolves around the incidental material generated at PFWN during the treating/processing of the Canadian waste. The Northwest Interstate Compact treats this incidental material as attributable to the Canadian consignees. The Canadian waste and incidental waste generated at PFWN would not be eligible for disposal at the Clive, UT or Richland, WA commercial LLRW disposal facilities. Any shipping containers that are not reused/recycled must also be returned to the Canadian consignees.
