

To Whom It May Concern:

Pursuant to 32 IL Adm. Code 335.1040(b), the administration of CardioSpecialists Group, Ltd., acknowledges **Ioannis Xenidis, D.O.** as the Radiation Safety Officer for our NRC radioactive materials license - 13-32400-01. We fully support Dr. Xenidis' efforts in this capacity and shall provide him with sufficient authority, organizational freedom, time, resources and management prerogative to:

1. Identify radiation safety-related problems and initiate, recommend or provide corrective actions;
2. Stop unsafe operations;
3. Verify implementation of corrective actions;
4. Keep the management current of the IEMA rules & Regulation
5. Provide guidance in maintaining a sound radiation safety program functioning in accord with applicable NRC regulations, and statements, conditions and duties and responsibilities of the RSO contained in this licensee's radioactive materials license application and supporting documents;
6. Review radiation monitoring reports to ensure exposures are ALARA, to ensure compliance with applicable NRC regulations, and ensure that monitoring devices are used and exchanged at prescribed frequency, and documentation is maintained to demonstrate that individuals are not likely to receive, in one year, a radiation dose in excess of 10% of the allowable limits, or that personnel monitoring devices are provided per license statements.
7. Ensure that records of receipt, use, disposal and transport of licensed material are current and complete and in accord with applicable NRC and DOT regulations
8. Ensure that personnel training is conducted and is commensurate with the individual's duties regarding licensed material, and review the radiation safety program at least annually and report findings to management;
9. Investigate and report medical events and ensure corrective actions are implemented;
10. Ensure that proper authorities are notified of incidents such as loss or theft of licensed material, damage to or malfunction of sealed sources, fire;
11. Ensure that licensed material is properly secured and disposed;
12. Ensure that personnel are trained commensurate with their duties regarding licensed materials;
13. Keep the facility's NRC license current;
14. Ensure that possession, use and storage of licensed material is consistent with the limitations in the license;
15. Ensure that individuals installing, relocating, maintaining, adjusting or repairing devices containing radioactive sealed sources are trained and authorized by an NRC or Agreement State license;
16. Documentation is maintained to demonstrate, by measurement or calculation, that the total effective dose equivalent to the individual likely to receive the highest dose from licensed operations does not exceed the annual limit for members of the public;
17. Medical events and precursor events are investigated and reported to the NRC, and cause and appropriate corrective action(s) are identified and timely corrective actions taken;
18. Audit the radiation safety program is conducted at least annually and documented;
19. If violations of regulations, license conditions or program weaknesses are identified, effective corrective actions are developed, implemented and documented;
20. Licensed material is transported, or offered for transport, in accordance with all applicable DOT regulations.
21. Appropriate radiation safety records are maintained; and
22. An up-to-date license is maintained and amendment and renewal requests are submitted in a timely manner, and in accordance with statements contained in the NRC license application and applicable NRC 10 CFR Part 20 Code regulations.
