Subject: [External_Sender] RAI 5.7-7 clarification item

Dave,

Per our discussion you had requested clarification of part of our response to RAI 5.7-7 regarding “where the 1 Sand is not present and the aquiclude is 50 feet or greater, no monitoring is required as per WDEQ”. The precedent for this requirement comes from our own Nichols Ranch Unit, Production Area #1 Hydrologic Text Document (aka Wellfield Package). The hydrologic test document was submitted and approved by the WDEQ-LQD (per permit 778 and Non Coal Rules Chapter 11) and also by the NRC (per License Condition 10.8). Both the NRC and the WDEQ-LQD approved fifty feet or greater of 1 A Mudstone thickness as an adequate aquiclude below the A Sand which does not require a monitor well for the underlying aquifer. The description of this is located in Section 3 of the hydrologic test document.
