Dear Mr. Denton:


Recent discussions have been held between Mr. Bill Cline of the Region II Staff and Mr. R. M. Glover of Duke Power Company concerning my March 9, 1983 letter to you on this subject.

Basically, the Staff is asking for the following commitment: If the exemption request is approved (thus allowing the CMC Staff to participate in emergency exercises at the same frequency as the TSC staffs—i.e., once per year) will Duke Power agree to full Crisis Management Center operation, (as defined in the Crisis Management Plan) anytime the State of North Carolina or South Carolina, for McGuire and Oconee, respectively, intend to conduct a full-scale exercise at those plants?

Duke Power Company's response is that we will make such a commitment. In essence, we will activate the Crisis Management Team fully in any full-scale exercise involving full state participation. If there are no full-scale exercises planned for Duke Power nuclear stations in a calendar year, we will choose one of the local exercises in which to have the CMC fully participate.

Also, per earlier discussions between Mr. Cline and Mr. Glover, we will make a separate exemption request for Catawba Nuclear Station after the operating license is granted.
