Dear Sir:

By letter dated December 26, 1984, the NRC provided for our response a status report on Multiplant Action C-14 regarding the Oconee Emergency Feedwater (EFW) System. Subsequent to the review of the 1982 Technical Evaluation Report (TER) developed by Lawrence Livermore National Laboratory (LLNL) and supplemental information provided by Duke Power Company (Duke) on October 13, 1982, the NRC identified the Open Items involved in the following areas:

1. Capability of the Auxiliary Feedwater (AFW) System and/or Standby Shutdown Facility (SSF) to withstand a safe shutdown earthquake concurrent with a single active failure;
2. Switchover procedures for transferring the AFW function to the SSF;
3. Requirements for the isolation boundary between the AFW System and the SSF; and
4. Walkdown of the currently nonseismically qualified areas of the AFW System.

Currently, Duke is reviewing the status report on Multiplant Action C-14 provided by your letter dated December 26, 1984, and is in the process of preparing a response. Duke anticipates to provide a response by March 26, 1985.
