Your letter dated January 4, 1985, transmitted your initial review of our September 1, 1983, response to Generic Letter 82-33 regarding conformance to Regulatory Guide 1.97 Revision 2 criteria for the Point Beach Nuclear Plant. You requested that we review that interim report and respond to the open items listed therein within 60 days of our receipt of the letter. In a letter dated March 11, 1985, we stated that we would be unable to respond to the January 4 letter until August 1, 1985.

We have recently been informed that during the week of July 22, 1985, NRC Inspection and Enforcement will be performing a post-implementation inspection of our environmental qualification (EQ) program. Based on a telephone discussion with Mr. Dick Wilson, the NRC inspection team leader, it is apparent that the Wisconsin Electric personnel who are preparing our response to your January 4 letter will be needed to participate in that inspection for the entire week of July 22. In addition, these same Wisconsin Electric personnel are currently involved with the correction of EQ documentation deficiencies identified during an internal audit by the Wisconsin Electric Quality Assurance Section and the transfer of EQ documentation forms to a new computerized data-base system. These same Wisconsin Electric personnel were also involved with the recently com-

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pleted Unit 1 outage and with the verification review of upgraded Emergency Operating Procedures at PBNP.

For these reasons, and based on a telephone conversation between Mr. R. K. Hanneman of our staff and Mr. T. G. Colburn, the NRC Project Manager for Point Beach, we are informing you that we will be unable to respond to your January 4, 1985 letter until September 1, 1985.
