SUBJECT: SUMMARY OF PUBLIC MEETING WITH SOUTH CAROLINA

ELECTRIC AND GAS COMPANY, SOUTHERN NUCLEAR AND

WESTINGHOUSE ELECTRIC COMPANY TO DISCUSS THE AP1000

**INITIAL TEST PROGRAM** 

The U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) staff held a Category 2 public meeting with South Carolina Electric & Gas (SCE&G), Southern Nuclear Operating Company (SNC), and Westinghouse Electric Company (WEC) on August 16, 2016. The purpose of the meeting was to discuss issues associated with the AP1000 Initial Test Program (ITP) to be implemented at SCE&G's VC Summer Units 2 & 3 and SNC's Vogtle Units 3 & 4 construction projects.

#### Summary of Meeting:

On August 16, 2016, staff from the NRC conducted a public meeting with representatives from SCE&G, SNC and WEC to discuss issues associated with the ITP which is being developed for implementation at VC Summer Units 2 & 3 and Vogtle Units 3 & 4. Specifically, the meeting provided a forum for both AP1000 licensees to update the NRC staff on progress in ITP development.

The NRC staff from the Office of New Reactors and Region II provided an overview of the ITP oversight objectives from a regulatory perspective, including tentative plans for ITP programmatic inspections in late 2016, followed by a brief from the licensees on ITP progress. At the end of this portion of the meeting, there was an opportunity for members of the public to provide comments and questions. No comments or questions were provided, and the public portion of the meeting was adjourned.

During the closed portion of the meeting, the licensees and WEC provided a progress update on ITP procedure development and schedule. Additionally, there was a discussion of Digital Instrumentation and Control (DI&C) testing strategy, followed by a discussion of ITP lessons captured by the licensees and WEC from testing activities at the AP1000 construction projects in China.
