Re: NRC Advanced Notification Program

Dear Mr. Easson,

Let this letter serve as notice that the Morongo Band of Mission Indians is entitled to receive advance notification of shipments of irradiated reactor fuel and certain nuclear waste in accordance with Title 10 Code of Federal Regulations (10 CFR), Parts 71 and 73.

The Morongo Band of Mission Indians, in exercising its sovereign authority over the land within the exterior boundaries of the Morongo Band of Mission Indians Reservation, and to further the Tribe's commitment to the safety of the community herein determines this action necessary.

Please be advised that, in accordance with the Nuclear Regulatory Commission's Action: Final Rule and Implementation of Advanced Notification to Native American Tribes of certain shipments of Nuclear Waste as posted in the Federal Register [NRC-1999-00S], the Morongo Band of Mission Indians hereby appoints Floyd Velasquez, Emergency Services Manager, as the primary and Michael Levine, Chief of Tribal Law Enforcement as the secondary points of contact to receive Safeguards Information with respect to the NRC's Final Rule and Implementation of Advanced Notification to Native American Tribes.


Also be advised, Mr. Velasquez and Chief Levine have completed Safeguards Information (SGI) training and understand the terms and conditions detailed in the following documents:

- Safeguards Information Awareness Training
- Protection of Safeguards Information Requirements for Tribes participating in the Advanced Notification of Irradiated Reactor Fuel Shipments

- REGULATORY GUIDE 5.79 as well as the statutory requirements of 10CFR § 73.21 and 10CFR § 73.22.

Further, the Morongo Band of Mission Indians confirms that the reservation boundaries, as shown in the attached map of the Morongo Band of Mission Indians Reservation, are true and correct and should be referenced for shipping routes. Please note that any and all prior maps of the Reservation provided should not be utilized as the attached map is the most current as of the submission of this letter.
