
Dear Mr. Donaldson:

This refers to your letter dated June 23, 2016, requesting that an Alternate Radiation Safety Officer (ARSO) be added to the NRC license. Based on our policy, the licensee may have an ARSO who has been delegated certain day-to-day tasks of the radiation protection program to assist the RSO and who may act as an emergency contact when the RSO is unavailable. However, only the primary RSO is named on the license. If the licensee is going to replace the primary RSO or when the RSO permanently discontinues performance of duties under the license, please provide an amendment request to name a new RSO.

Based on the above, we have voided your request. This was discussed with you on September 14, 2016. If you have any questions or require clarification on any of the information stated above, you may contact us at (630) 829-9887.
