Oconee Nuclear Station, Docket Nos. 50-269, 50-270, and 50-287;
McGuire Nuclear Station, Docket Nos. 50-369 and 50-370; and,
Catawba Nuclear Station, Docket Nos. 50-413 and 50-414.

Gentlemen:

This letter contains proposed amendments to the Technical Specifications for; Oconee Nuclear Station (Facility Operating License Nos. DPR-38, DPR-47, and DPR-55); McGuire Nuclear Station (Facility Operating License Nos. NPF-9 and NPF-17); and, Catawba Nuclear Station (Facility Operating License Nos. NPF-35 and NPF-52). This request involves relocating the Radiological Effluent Technical Specifications (RETS) to the respective stations Selected Licensee Commitment (SLC) Manual. Relocating the RETS to the SLC Manual, instead of the Offsite Dose Calculation Manual (ODCM) and the Process Control Program, is a deviation from the guidance provided by Generic Letter 89-01; however, this deviation was previously discussed with the Project Directorate Staff and was considered an acceptable proposed alternative. With the exception of the relocation document, this submittal has been prepared and submitted in accordance with the guidance provided by Generic Letter 89-01, and 10 CFR 50.90.

Attachment No. 1 contains the justification/technical discussion, no significant hazards analysis, and environmental impact analysis. The proposed changes to each station's Technical Specifications are identified in Attachment No. 2 for Oconee Nuclear Station; No. 3 for McGuire Nuclear Station; and, No. 4 for Catawba Nuclear Station. Attachments No. 5 for Oconee Nuclear Station; No. 6 for McGuire Nuclear Station; and, No. 7 for Catawba Nuclear Station provide the RETS requirements as they would be relocated to the respective station's SLC Manual.

We request that the proposed changes in this submittal be reviewed and approved by June 1, 1990. This date coincides with the implementation date of the Catawba Nuclear Station SLC Manual and with our annual update to the ODCM. Due to the large number of station procedures and/or directives affected by this change, we also request that implementation of the changes become effective 30 days from the issuance of the amendment.



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
