BRIEF DESCRIPTION: The KSC Radiation Protection Officer (RPO) is responsible for ensuring the safe use of all ionizing and nonionizing radiation at KSC, including byproduct radioactive material authorized under the Center's Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) Broad Scope license. The KSC RPO is responsible for managing the radiation protection program; identifying radiation protection problems; initiating, recommending, or providing corrective actions; verifying implementation of corrective actions; and ensuring compliance with KSC, NASA, and Federal regulations governing its use. The RPO has the authority to immediately stop any operations involving sources of ionizing or nonionizing radiation in which health and safety may be compromised or which may result in noncompliance with NRC requirements.


