We received your letter dated September 13, 2016, providing some information on behalf of Dr. Frank Kolodziej regarding potential business changes for International Cyclotron. Your letter provided some general information which does not change the status of the license or facilities which require decommissioning.

Your letter did not respond to the two specific actions identified in the August 30, 2016, correspondence. It is important for Dr. Kolodziej to take the specified actions by the dates identified in the letter or the NRC may impose civil penalties as described. It is essential that NRC receive Dr. Kolodziej's response by the deadlines, the first of which is September 29, 2016.
