In accordance with MD 8.11, which governs the NRC petition process, I am writing to provide you the periodic update on your 2.206 petition. I would like to inform you that the petition is still under review. On July 20, 2016, the petition review board (PRB) met internally to discuss the NRC staff's resolution of the issues relating to the petition. The PRB is working towards providing final recommendations. I will keep you updated on the progress of the petition.

Also, on a related subject, I would like to inform you that Entergy (or the licensee) has submitted a letter on September 8, 2016 (ADAMS Accession No. ML16252A482) requesting an extension to comply with NRC Order EA-13-109, "Order Modifying Licenses with Regard to Reliable Hardened Containment Vents Capable of Operations Under Severe Accident Conditions" for the James A. Fitzpatrick plant. The NRC staff is reviewing this request.
