Cyber Monitoring and Incident Response Contract

On September 8, 2016, contract number NRC-HQ-10-16-C-0003 was awarded to Business Integra Technology Solutions, Inc. in Bethesda, Maryland. The objective of this contract is to provide cyber monitoring and incident response services to the Office of Chief Information Officer's Information Security Directorate. The period of performance is from October 1, 2016 through September 30, 2017, with four one-year options. The potential value over the life of the contract is \$3,045,640.
