This is in reference to your application dated July 27, 2016 requesting a new Nuclear Regulatory Commission License No. 19-35377-01. In order to continue our review, we need the following additional information:

1. Please confirm that you wish to be authorized for 40 mCi of C-14 and 480 mCi of H-3. This will eliminate any need for Financial Assurance.
2. Please specify the source model numbers, if known, for Ba-133, Co-57, and Cs-137, excluding the irradiator sources. If some sources are legacy sources pending disposal, please indicate that as well.
3. Please confirm that Authorized Users (AUs) will also receive annual radiation safety training, or update your Training Metric Table accordingly.
4. Please have your response signed and dated by a member of senior management. A scanned copy of a signed letter will suffice.
