Dear Mr. Stoddard:

On August 26, 2016, the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) completed a security inspection at your Millstone Power Station. The NRC inspectors discussed the results of this inspection with Mr. John Daugherty, Site Vice President, and other members of your staff. Inspectors documented the results of this inspection in the enclosed report.

NRC inspectors documented four findings of very low security significance (Green) in this report. These findings involved violations of NRC requirements. Further, NRC inspectors documented a licensee-identified violation which was determined to be of very low security significance. The NRC is treating these violations as non-cited violations (NCV) consistent with Section 2.3.2.a of the Enforcement Policy.

If you contest these violations or the significance, you should provide a response within 30 days of the date of this inspection report, with the basis for your denial, to the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission, ATTN: Document Control Desk, Washington DC 20555 0001; with copies to the Regional Administrator, Region I; the Director, Office of Enforcement, U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission, Washington, DC 20555 0001; and the NRC resident inspector at the Millstone Power Station.

Three cross-cutting aspects were assigned to the findings in the area of Human Performance; Conservative Bias, because Dominion failed to use decision making-practices that emphasize prudent choices over those that are simply allowable [H.14], Avoid Complacency, because Dominion failed to recognize and plan for the possibility of mistakes and implement appropriate error reduction tools [H.12], and Procedure Adherence, because Dominion failed to follow processes, procedures, and work instructions [H.8]. Additionally, one cross-cutting aspect was assigned to the findings in the area of Problem Identification and Resolution, Resolution, because Dominion failed to take effective corrective actions to address issues in a timely manner [P.3]. If you disagree with the cross-cutting aspect assignment in this report, you should provide a response within 30 days of the date of this inspection report, with the basis for your disagreement, to the Regional Administrator, Region I; and the NRC resident inspector at the Millstone Power Station.
