In 2009, the Commission directed the staff to keep the Commission informed of the status of three rulemaking activities related to emergency core cooling system requirements. The staff has issued semi-annual Commissioner Assistants notes in response to this direction. The staff no longer believes the updates are necessary because the rulemaking to redefine a large break loss-of-coolant accident (10 CFR 50.46a) has been discontinued, the draft final rule to improve emergency core cooling system acceptance criteria (10 CFR 50.46c) is currently before the Commission for consideration, and the staff is separately tracking a task to provide a notation vote paper to the Commission on its reevaluation of the need to revise General Design Criterion 35. I agree with the NRC staff that semi-annual updates on these three rulemaking activities are no longer necessary and approve closing the outdated tasking. If the NRC staff determines that it would not be prudent to proceed with the GDC 35 rulemaking after conducting the September 29, 2016, follow-up public meeting to seek stakeholders' views, the staff should promptly notify the Commission and seek approval to terminate this activity.
