You did not provide any information associated with your new facility located at 4 Laser Lane, Wallingford, Connecticut, other than the address. NUREG-1556, Volume 7, "Consolidated Guidance About Materials Licenses Program-Specific Guidance About Academic, Research and

Development, and Other Licenses of Limited Scope," in section 8.9 states to provide the facility and equipment. Please describe the facilities and equipment (e.g., remote handling equipment, storage containers, shielding) to be made available at the 4 Laser Lane location where licensed material will be used. Submit a description of the areas assigned for the receipt, storage, preparation, and measurement of licensed materials. Submit a diagram showing the locations of shielding, the proximity of radiation sources to unrestricted areas, and other items related to radiation safety. Diagrams should be drawn to a specified scale, or dimensions should be indicated.
