Background

- OPPD is a publicly-owned electric utility and is a political subdivision of the state of Nebraska
- Governed by a publicly elected Board of Directors
- On 5/12/16, OPPD management recommended ceasing FCS operations to the Board of Directors
- On 6/16/16, OPPD Board of Directors voted and approved ceasing FCS operations and going to SAFSTOR



Initial NRC Submittals

- Initial certification to Permanently Cease Operations by 12/31/16 submitted on 6/24/16
- Updated certification submitted on 8/25/16, FCS will Permanently Cease Operations on 10/24/16
- Certification of Permanent Removal of Fuel from the Reactor Vessel will be submitted in November 2016



Decommissioning Approach

- Multidisciplinary teams supplemented with several vendors with decommissioning experience
- Benchmarking Trips to Crystal River, Vermont Yankee, Zion, Kewaunee; future trips planned
- Industry decommissioning groups
 - Nuclear Energy Institute (NEI) Decommissioning Transition Team
 - Industry Regulatory Assurance (RA) Decommissioning Users Group
 - Emergency Planning Decommissioning Users Group
- Decommissioning Oversight Committee




Key SAFSTOR Decision Points

Emergency Plan Changes Post Shutdown EPlan

- Submitted 9/2/16
- Revised on-shift and Emergency Response Organization (ERO) staffing based on analysis of required post-shutdown ERO positions but does not change any Emergency Action Level (EALs)
- Meeting with all supporting offsite agencies held on 9/8/16; additional meetings are scheduled
- Verification drills including offsite agencies scheduled for first quarter 2017



Emergency Plan Changes

Supporting submittals

- Certified Fuel Handler (CFH) Training Program submitted on 7/7/16
 - One Request for Additional Information (RAI) received; response provided 10/7/16
- Technical Specifications (TS), Section 5, Administrative Controls, License Amendment Request (LAR) submitted 9/28/16
- Severe Weather Security Plan Exemption Request (10CFR73.55) submitted 10/7/16



Emergency Plan Changes Permanently Defueled EPlan

- Revises EALs, removes all offsite ERO functions and significantly reduces ERO staffing
- Initial draft prepared and undergoing crossdisciplinary team & offsite agency reviews
- Supporting vendor analyses: Zirconium Fire, Shine, Radiation Monitor Set Points and updated Fuel Handling Accident Boundary Dose
- Permanently Defueled EPIan and associated Exemption Requests (10CFR50.47 & App E) will be submitted December 2016
