Regarding IE Bulletin 80-10, which was transmitted by your letter of May 6, 1980, Duke Power Company has now completed the review of the Oconee Nuclear Station (ONS) design and operation as required by Action Item 1. In addition, monitoring programs have been established for those systems identified in the review as being non-radioactive, but having the potential for becoming contaminated through interfaces with radioactive systems. This completes the requirement of Action Item 2 of this bulletin. Finally, the appropriate administrative controls have been implemented to insure that the requirements of Action Items 3 and 4 are satisfied. The specifics of the actions taken above are documented and available for review at the ONS site, as required by the subject bulletin.

My letter of June 23, 1980 addressed the delays in the reviews required by this bulletin.
