

Regarding IE Bulletin 80-20, which was transmitted by your letter of July 31, 1980, Duke Power Company has completed a review of the Oconee Nuclear Station which has indicated that the Westinghouse Type W-2 switches with spring return-to-neutral (auto) position are not used in safety-related applications at this station. Additionally, there are no plans for use of this type switch at Oconee.

Per your request for estimated manpower expended in responding to this bulletin, approximately 36 manhours were required to perform the review and report its results.
