ANNETTE VIETTI-COOK: This is Entergy Nuclear Vermont Yankee, LLC, and Entergy Nuclear Operations, Inc. (Vermont Yankee Nuclear Power Station)

The Commission is being asked to act on a Memorandum and Order addressing the petition filed by the State of Vermont, the Vermont Yankee Nuclear Power Corporation, and Green Mountain Power Corporation (together, Petitioners) seeking review of, and a discretionary hearing on, a number of issues associated with use of decommissioning trust funds at Vermont Yankee Nuclear Power Station.

The Commission, with Commissioner Svinicki dissenting in part and Commissioner Baran dissenting in part, has voted to approve a Memorandum and Order that directs the Staff to analyze the environmental effects of the exemption request and denies the Petitioners' remaining requests for relief.
