Dear Ms. Smith:

In letter dated August 2, 2016 (ML16218A420), you contacted the U.S. NRC to request – among other things – the termination of the Bronson Lakeview Hospital radioactive materials license, NRC License No. 21-26716-01. Upon request from our office for additional information, you submitted an NRC Form 314 dated August 31, 2016 (ML16245A379, including attachments) and signed by you. In an additional information letter dated October 5, 2016 (ML16288A505), you submitted additional information including a September 19, 2016 letter, leak tests, and area surveys sufficient to permit the transfer of facilities at 408 Hazen Street in Paw Paw, Michigan, to another NRC licensee – Bronson Methodist Hospital, NRC License No. 21-13125-01. In your letters, as Radiation Safety Officer (RSO) for the licensee Bronson Lakeview Hospital, you also confirmed that the licensee wishes to terminate its NRC License No. 21-26716-01.

You confirmed that, upon completion of the attached termination and the amendment of the Bronson Methodist Hospital license, NRC License No. 21-13125-01, adding the Hazen Street location of use to that license, all residual licensed material from Bronson Lakeview Hospital will be under the control of Bronson Methodist Hospital.


Based on its review, the staff has concluded that all licensable radioactive material at 408 Hazen Street in Paw Paw, Michigan, has been transferred from Bronson Lakeview Hospital, NRC License No. 21-26716-01 to Bronson Methodist Hospital, NRC License No. 21-13125-01. Based on this conclusion, no further remediation or actions with respect to NRC regulated material are required on the part of Bronson Lakeview Hospital. The NRC understands that all records concerning the safe and effective decommissioning of the 408 Hazen Street facility have been transferred to and will be maintained by Bronson Methodist Hospital, NRC License No. 21-13125-01. Accordingly, NRC license number 21-26716-01 is hereby terminated. A copy of the terminated license – Amendment No. 12 – is enclosed.
