Courtesy Notice: This email is to document that verbal contact was given to your office on 10/28/16 reporting missed MP sampling in Mine Unit C for October. (WDEQ Permit 633, NRC Source License SUA-1548)

Missed sampling of Production Monitor Wells (MP Wells) in Mine Unit C:

MP-wells in Mine Unit C needed to be sampled by the end of October to meet requirements of Section 2.1 of the Reclamation Plan of the WDEQ Permit 633. If sampling cannot be completed, notification to WDEQ-LQD is to be given within 7 days.

Due to safety concerns, headers in Mine Unit C are being rebuilt thus preventing the sampling activities for MP wells. The possibility of this event occurring was discussed with the NRC/LQD when missed MP well sampling happened for Mine Unit D/D Ext in September. Headers are in the process of being rebuilt in Mine Unit C and is expected to be completed before the end of November. Mine Unit C MP wells will be sampled in December as scheduled.

Missed sampling does not create a risk to the environment and groundwater restoration activities are not impacted. MP-wells are not used for excursion monitoring but only to track progress of groundwater restoration. In accordance with License condition 12.1, we are required to provide a written notification to the NRC when an event requires reporting to the WDEQ. The notification will be sent out on or before November 3, 2016 to both the NRC and LQD.
