Dear Mr. Maloney:

Enclosed is Amendment No. 3 to your NRC Material License No. 21-26441-01 in accordance with your request.

Please note that your license has been placed in standby pending disposal of your gauges and the termination of your license. After you have properly transferred all radioactive materials, you may request that your license be terminated. You may complete an NRC Form 314, "Certificate of Disposition of Materials," when requesting your license be terminated. For sealed sources that were transferred or disposed of as part of the close-out of this license, please provide a copy of the final leak test result for each sealed source; a copy of an acknowledgment of receipt from the licensed entity who took possession of each source, with an appropriate level of detail to identify the source and recipient; the NRC license number or copy of the Agreement State licensee that clearly shows it is licensed to receive your sources.

Please note that bills of lading, shipment manifests and shipping papers do not usually contain sufficient information to demonstrate that materials have been safely received by an appropriately licensed entity. They typically indicate that materials were prepared for shipment or transfer only, not that they were received and accepted into the recipient's inventory under its license.

Please review the enclosed document carefully and be sure that you understand all conditions. If there are any errors or questions, please notify the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission, Region III office at (630) 829-9887 so that we can provide appropriate corrections and answers.

The NRC's Safety Culture Policy Statement became effective in June 2011.
