I am responding to your letter dated August 18, 2016, which requested that the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) approve a new Truck Route designated as No. 253 for transporting spent nuclear fuel from the Sweetgrass Port of Entry in Sweet Grass, MT to the U.S. Department of Energy's Savannah River Site in Aiken, SC.

The NRC has reviewed your application and concluded that the information satisfies the requirements of Title 10 of the Code of Federal Regulations (10 CFR) Part 73.37. This letter constitutes approval of Truck Route No. 253 which will expire December 31, 2021. The NRC expects your periodic review and update of the emergency phone numbers associated with this route. Changes to emergency contact numbers do not qualify as a route deviation or change.
