Based on our telephone conversation with you on October 19, 2016, and after a follow-up review by U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) staff of historical records, NRC would like to withdraw its October 6, 2016, request to perform radiological surveys of your property. Further review of records clarify that your property at 203 Laurel Street, Hartford, Connecticut was mistakenly identified as a site of NRC interest.

Your property at 203 Laurel Street, Hartford, Connecticut is not a site where radium-226 was known or suspected to have been previously used. We apologize for any inconvenience, this mistake has been corrected in our records.
