Dear Mr. Stolz:

This letter is to confirm conversations with the Staff regarding seismic qualification of equipment associated with the diesel generators. The following items are seismically qualified:

- Fuel Oil Day Tanks
- Closed Cooling Water System, including Fan and Radiator
- Fuel Oil Storage Tanks and Fuel Oil Piping
- Lube Oil System
- Ventilation System

We also wish to confirm that a normally closed, A-rated three-hour fire door will separate the main condensers from the corridor connecting the diesel generator rooms. This door will be designed to prevent a postulated condenser leak from flooding the diesel generator rooms.

This information will be included in a future amendment to our operating license application. Five copies of this submittal have been sent directly to Mr. Dennis Allison.
