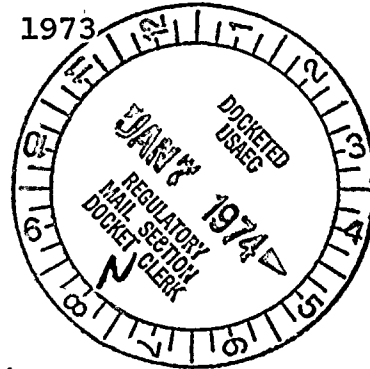

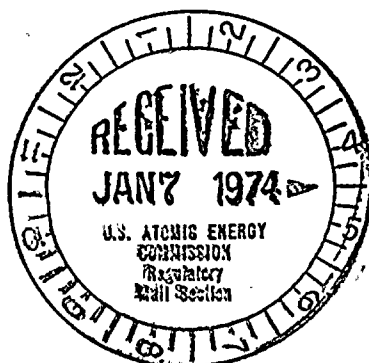
Your letter dated October 10, 1973, stated that the staff should be advised of the approach we intend to take to deal with the possibility of an anticipated transient without scram (ATWS).

Diablo Canyon Unit 1 (Docket 50-275) is in Class IC of WASH-1270. Unit 2 (Docket 50-323) is in Class IB. For both units we will submit an amendment to the FSAR by October 1, 1974, describing and evaluating the consequences of a postulated ATWS. The amendment will describe any plant changes for Unit 2 that are proposed, or that have been made by that time, to make the expected consequences in the event of an ATWS more acceptable.

In addition to and supporting this amendment our nuclear steam supply system supplier plans to submit a report of a generic nature to the AEC staff concerning the effects of ATWS on their systems.
