Item number 2 of Enclosure 2 to the MEB "Trip Report for Criteria Implementation Review Meetings With PG & E" has caused some confusion. The intent of this request for additional information should be clarified by the following rewording:

2. Seismic Anchor Movement Study (SAM Study)

Expand the SAM study to reflect the following criteria:

- a. Where primary stresses are produced in the supports (such as in supports consisting of a member in pure tension) the faulted condition loading combination to be used for the supports should be:

Hogri Inertia plus SAM plus Dead Weight

- b. Where the limiting condition for the supports arises in the loading combination when thermal expansion is considered, the SAM loads should be included.



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
