PGandE received a set of interrogatories from the San Luis Obispo Mothers For Peace dated June 21, 1976, responses to which are due July 6, 1976. PGandE expects to be able to answer those interrogatories dealing with environmental matters by this date, but requests an extension of time to and including July 20, 1976 to respond to the remainder. The persons working on the responses are also involved in preparing PGandE's presentation to the Advisory Committee on Reactor Safeguards, which is scheduled for July 8, 1976, and they will not be able to address the remaining interrogatories until after that date.

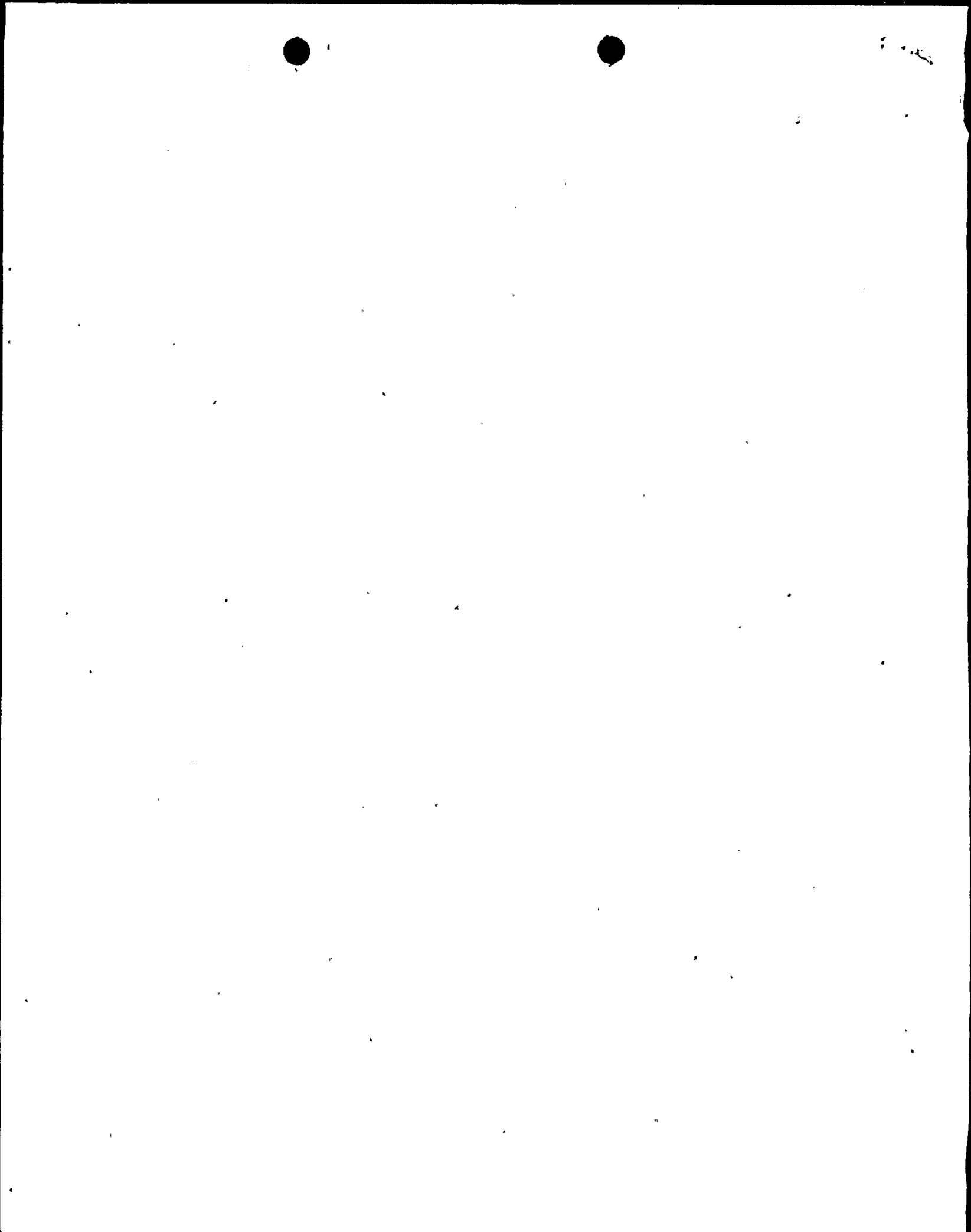

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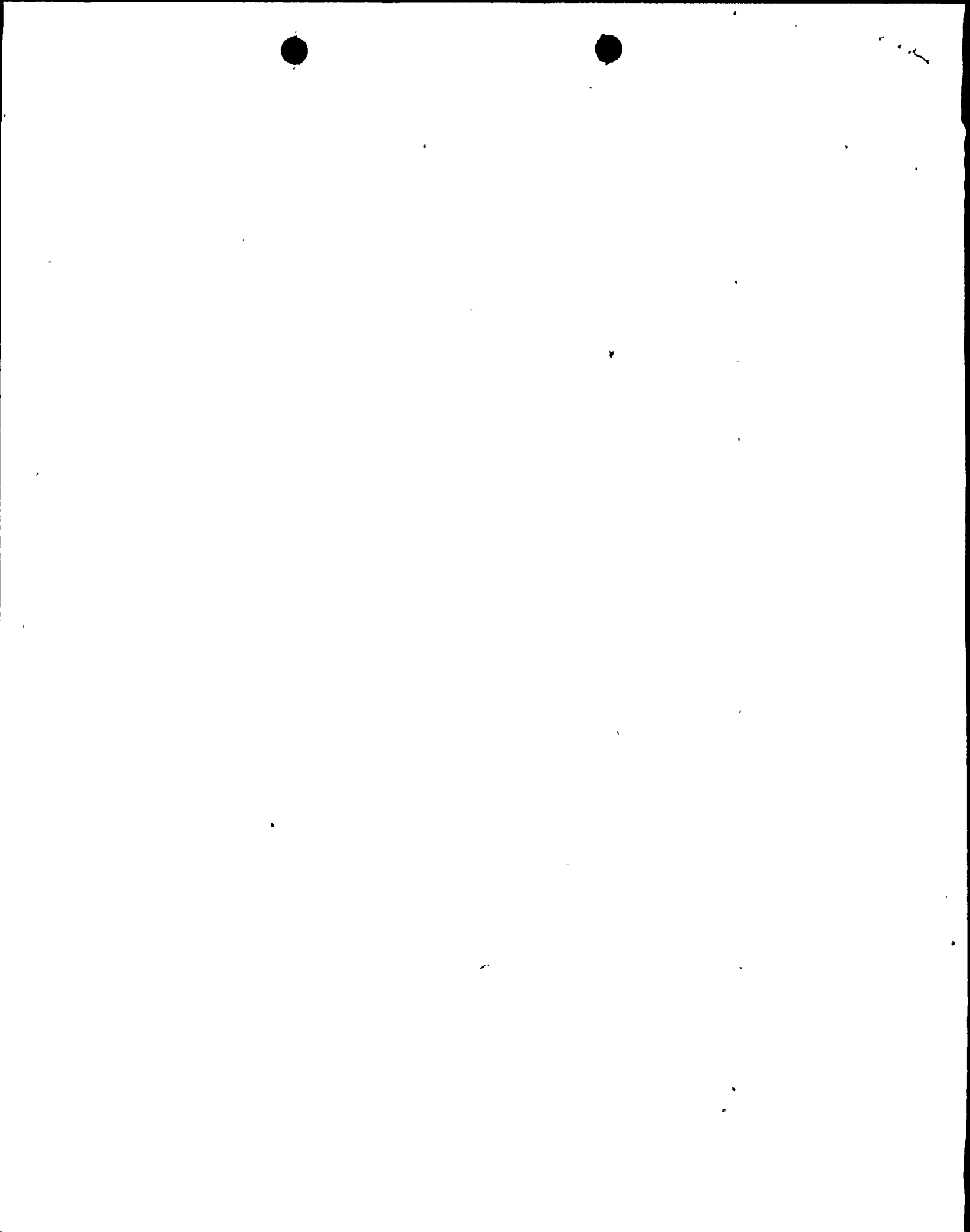
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
