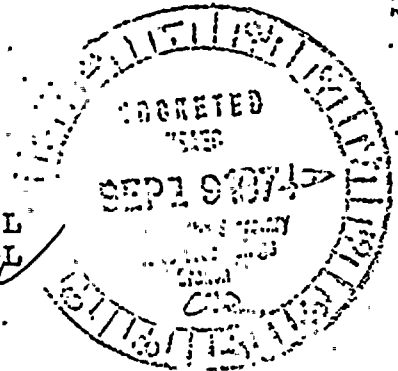

Dear Mr. Cornwell:

This is in reply to your letter to me dated September 9, 1974 concerning a conversation you had with John Garcia, a Pinkerton guard employed at the Diablo Canyon Power Plant. I have had this matter investigated and the facts are as follows:

On or about June 30, 1974 Fish and Game personnel removed from Diablo Cove one dead sea otter covered with severe lacerations. The Fish and Game personnel contacted the local Fish and Game office to discuss the advisability of doing an autopsy on the dead sea otter. Upon being informed that such an autopsy was not necessary the deceased sea otter was thrown back into Diablo Cove. This is the only instance we have been able to discover of any sea otters being placed in Diablo Cove, dead or alive.

Mr. Garcia has advised us that he has not seen any otters put in the water by Fish and Game personnel or anyone else. Apparently in his conversation with you Mr. Garcia was simply reporting a rumor he had heard. Thus, further conversations with him would not appear to be productive. If you wish further information, I suggest that you contact Mr. Don Gotshall of the State Department of Fish and Game. He works out of the Monterey office and his telephone number is (408) 373-0901.
