Gentlemen:

This refers to the inspection conducted by Messrs. A. D. Johnson and J. L. Crews of this office on April 19-21, 1972, of construction activities authorized by AEC Construction Permit No. CPPR-39, and to the discussion of their inspection findings held with Mr. W. R. Hersey and other members of your staff at the conclusion of the inspection.

Areas examined during this inspection included the changes to update your QA manual, changes in your program covering the production and inspection of reinforcing steel splices, your QA audit activities related to radiography of the auxiliary salt water piping, the pneumatic leakage test of the liquid holdup tanks, plans for installation of the steam generator supports, receipt, storage and installation of selected Class I components, plans and procedures for the modification of the tube sheet cladding in the No. 2 steam generator, and construction discrepancy reports. Within these areas, the inspection consisted of selective examinations of procedures and representative records, interviews with project personnel and observations by the inspectors.

The inspection also included an examination of the actions you have taken with respect to certain aspects of your reinforcing steel splicing program referenced in our letter of February 7, 1972. We have no further questions concerning those items.

No items of noncompliance were identified within the scope of this inspection.

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
