b) All documents, reports, and other writings in any way relating to physical testing of the ability of any DCNGS buildings, external and internal structures, equipment, components and parts to withstand seismic forces. This sub-category includes, but is not limited to, writings relating to shake-table testing of DCNGS internal structures, equipment, components, and parts.

c) All equipment, components and parts seismic classification lists and all other documents, reports, and writings relating to parts and equipment seismic classifications for DCNGS.

This document request does not include any portion of the DCNGS Final Safety Analysis Report. This document request encompasses writings relevant to several contentions in the Diablo Canyon operating license proceedings relating to the seismology of the plant site and the seismic design of the DCNGS.

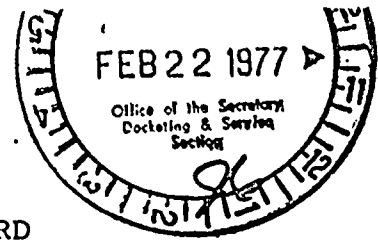

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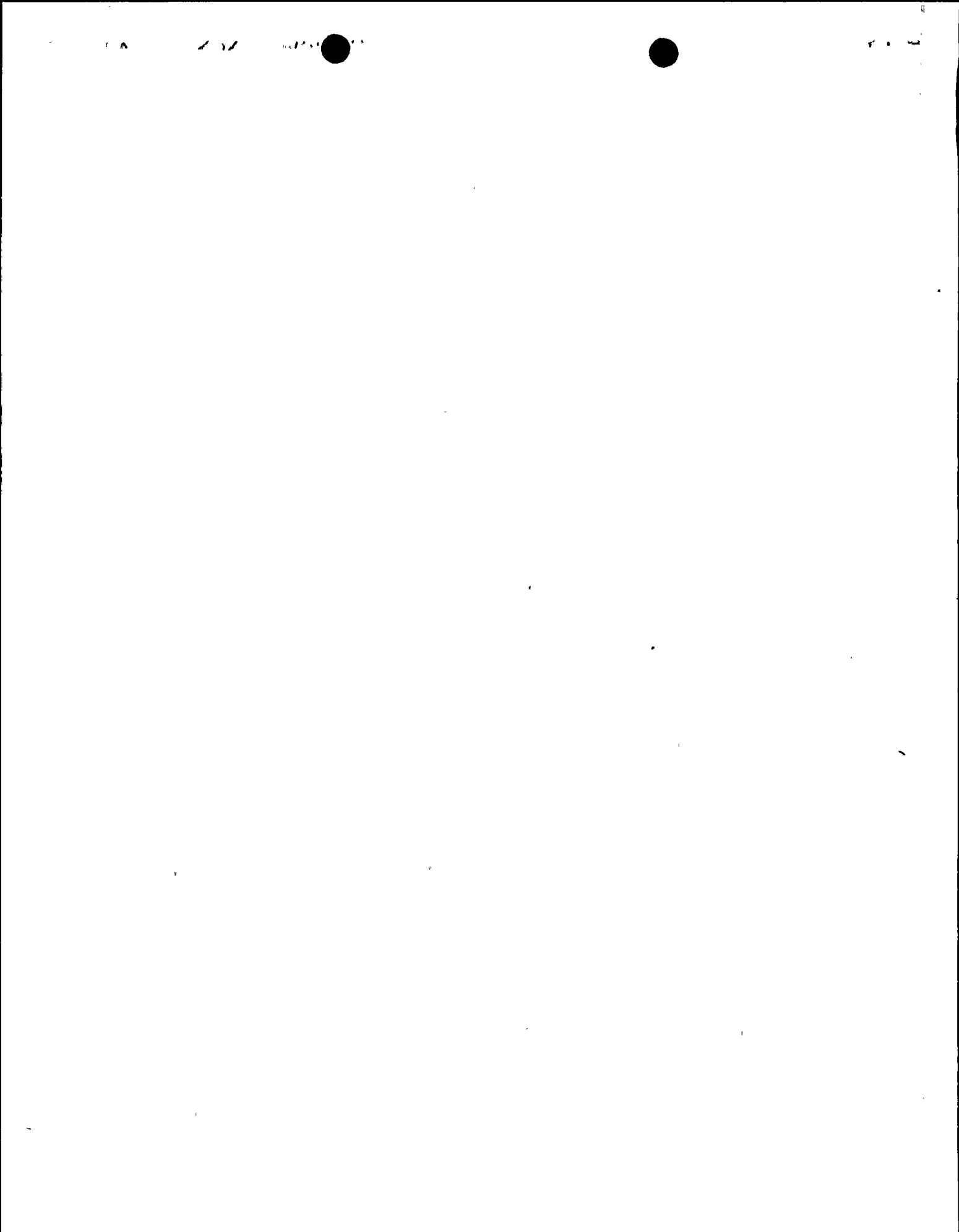
