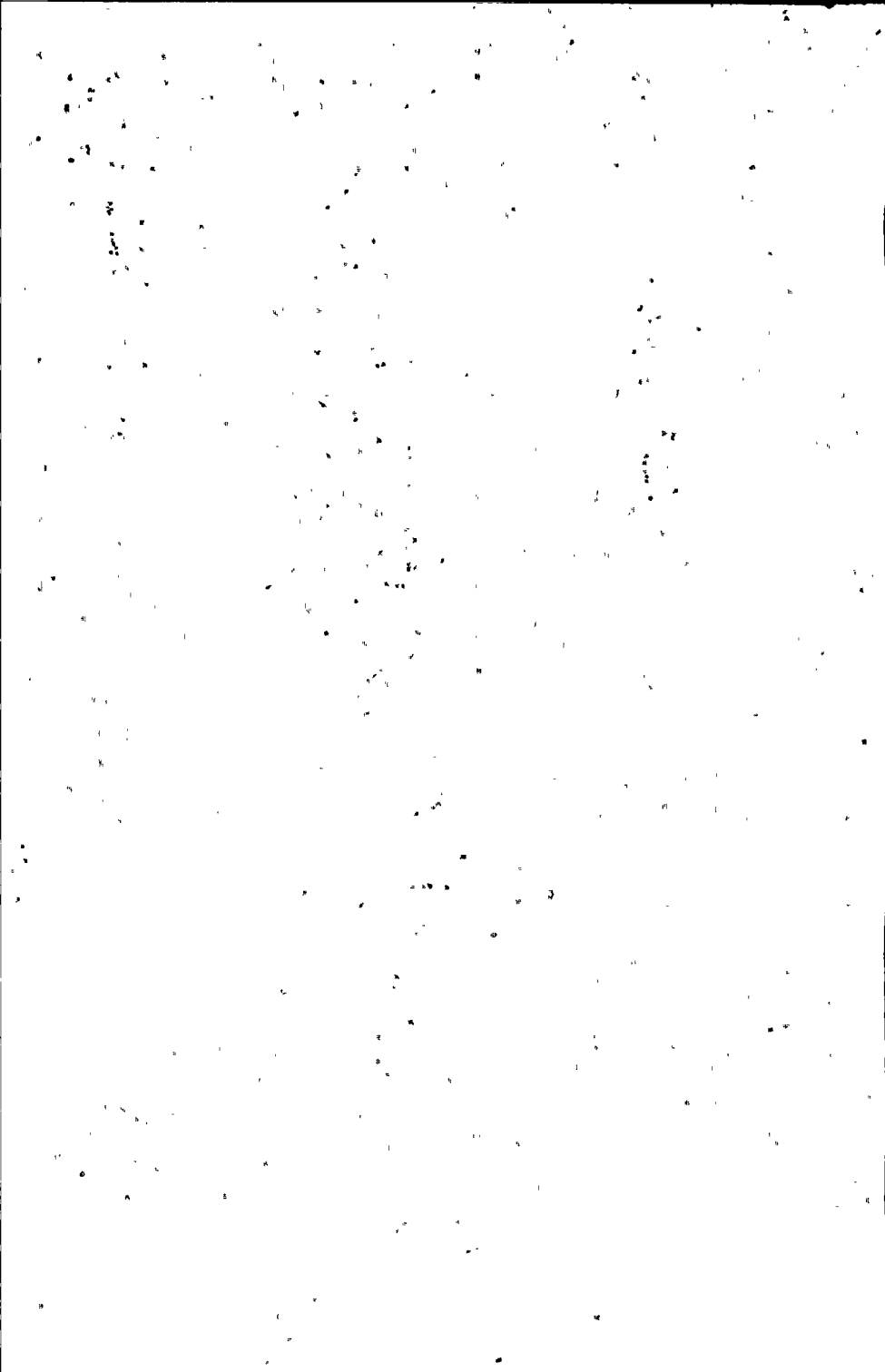

Dear Marc:

As you know, on June 30 the Subcommittee on Energy and the Environment will hold a hearing concerning the seismic hazard at the Diablo Canyon Nuclear Generating Station. In my letter of June 13 inviting NRC testimony at this hearing, I requested the presence of NRC staff who are most familiar with the situation. Accordingly, I am requesting that the following persons be available to answer questions that might arise: Mr. Edson Case, Mr. Richard^{De}Young, Mr. Renner Hoffman, and Mr. Dennis Allison.

Also in regard to the hearing, it is important that certain documents be made available for the record. These are documents requested in accordance with the Freedom of Information Act (FOIA) by the Center for Law in the Public Interest. While I appreciate that they might be exempt from compelled disclosure under the FOIA, release of certain of them will help to clarify the situation. Therefore, unless there is some overriding interest at stake, the rationale that the documents listed below contain staff advice and opinions is not a sufficient basis for withholding them from the public domain.
