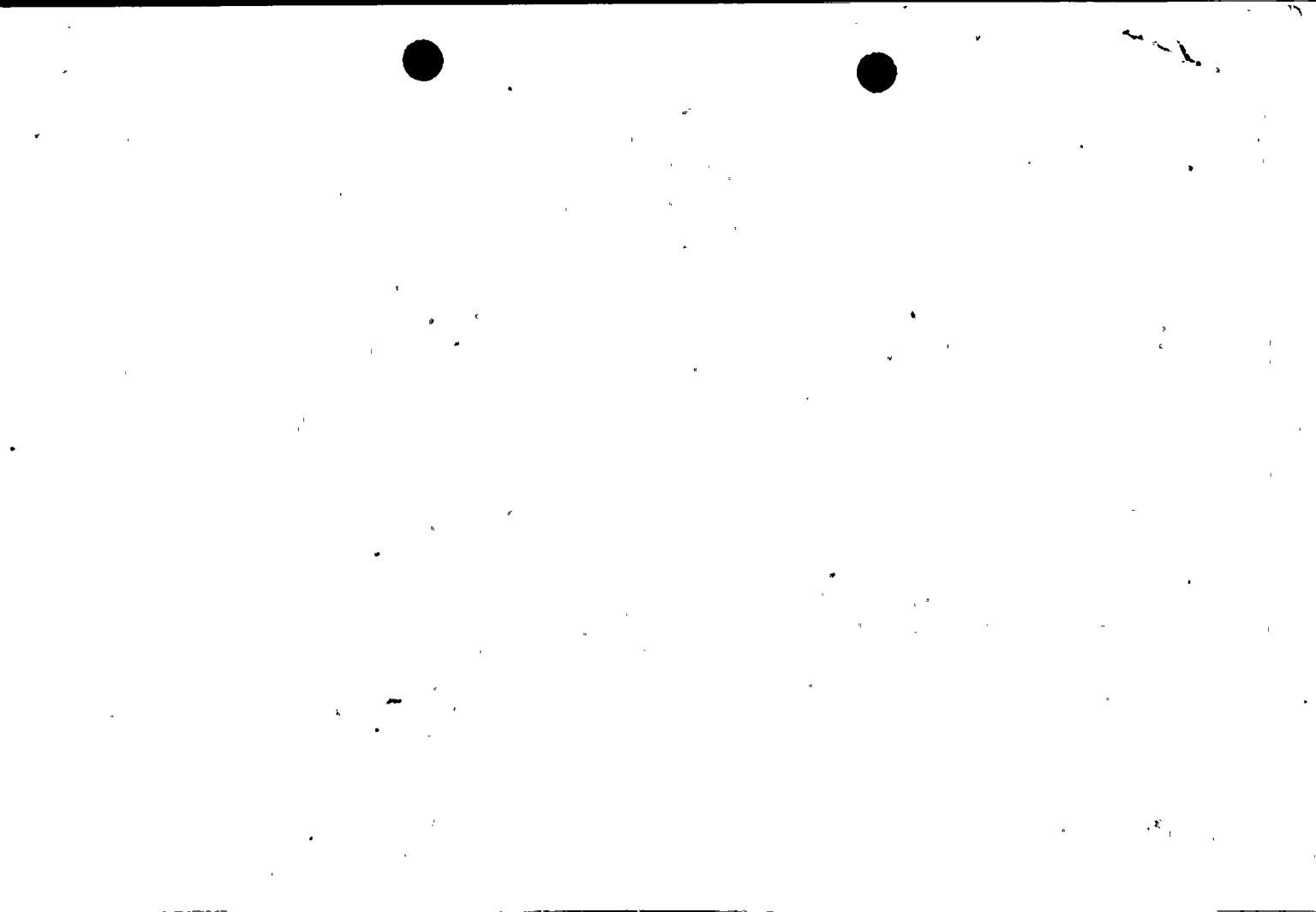


Dear Mr. Cammerer:

I have recently received inquiries as to the status of the Diablo Canyon nuclear-powered generating facility at San Luis Obispo from some of my constituents who are concerned about the prospect of interruptions of electrical service in California this summer.

It is my understanding that one unit at the Diablo Canyon facility has been ready for operation for some time, but that its licensing and operation have been delayed pending resolution of questions concerning earthquake safety.

I would appreciate any information you can provide concerning the current status of the Diablo Canyon facility and the procedural schedule and prospects for licensing and bringing the plant on line.
