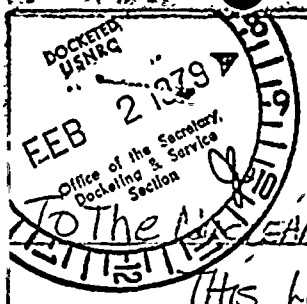

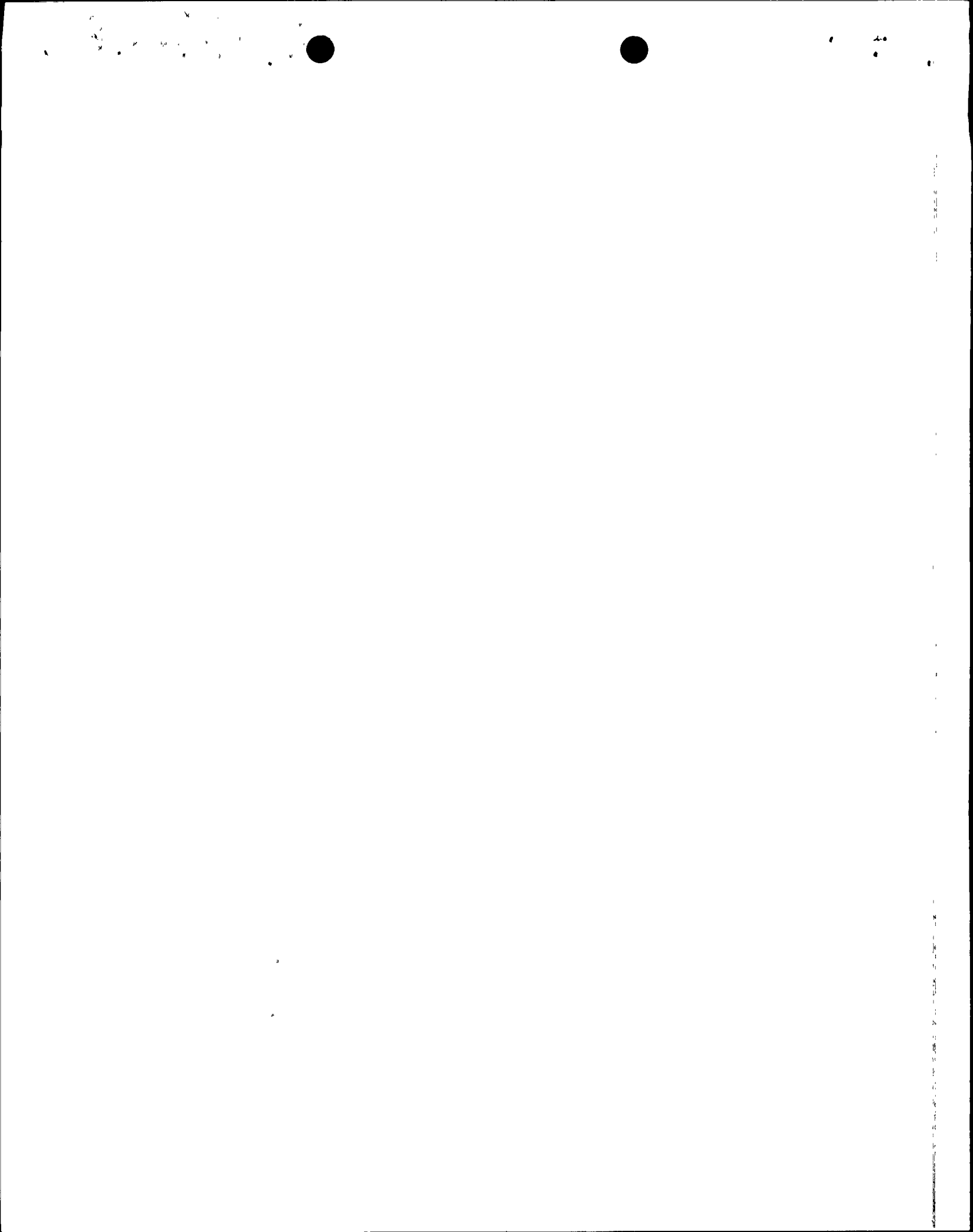

THIS LETTER IS SENT TO YOU FROM THE
SANLUIS OBISPO COUNTY JAIL WHERE I AM SERVING AN UNUSUALLY
HARSH SENTENCE FOR TRESPASSING ON P.G. & E. PROPERTY LAST AUG. 6.
THE SENTENCE HANDED DOWN IS HARSH AND DEFINITELY POLITICAL,
HOWEVER, I WOULD LIKE TO FOCUS THIS LETTER ON THE
NOTION OF APPEAL - IN VARIOUS FORMS - TO
THOSE PEOPLE AND AGENCIES WHO WIELD POWER
OVER THE PEOPLE OF THE UNITED STATES.

I WAS BORN IN 1942 - A WAR BABY. MY FATHER WAS
SERVING IN THE U.S. MARINE CORPS. WHEN HE RETURNED HOME
HE WORKED WITH THE F.B.I. AND LATER PRACTICED LAW
IN A SMALL MISSISSIPPI TOWN. I GREW UP IN A VERY
CONSERVATIVE HOME, TRUSTING THAT THOSE PEOPLE IN
RESPONSIBLE GOVERNMENT POSITIONS WERE THERE WITH THE
HIGHEST DEMOCRATIC IDEALS - TO SERVE THE PEOPLE OF THIS INCREDIBLY
BEAUTIFUL LAND, TO FURTHER THE PRINCIPLES OF DECLARATION OF
INDEPENDENCE (INCLUDING THE BILL OF RIGHTS), AND THE CONSTITUTION
OF THE UNITED STATES, Acknowledged by card. 2/2

LATER I BECAME A TEACHER OF HISTORY AND CIVICS IN
A SOUTHERN CITY. ALTHOUGH IT WAS CLEAR THAT QUITE OFTEN THE
TRUST PUT INTO GOVERNMENTAL AGENCIES WAS MISPLACED, STILL MY
BELIEF IN THE QUALITY OF JUDGEMENT AND INTEGRITY OF INTENT



CONTINUED. I IMPLORED MY STUDENTS TO STAY ABBREAST OF CURRENT EVENTS WITH AS CLEAR A HISTORICAL PERSPECTIVE AS POSSIBLE, I ADDED THEM OF THE CHANNELS OF COMMUNICATION BETWEEN THE PEOPLE OF THIS COUNTRY AND THOSE WHO SERVE THEM.

LATELY I HAVE FOUND THOSE CHANNELS TO BE FLOODED. OVER AND OVER CORPORATE ECONOMIC INTERESTS HAVE TAKEN PRECEDENT OVER THE WISHES AND SAFETY OF THE PEOPLE. THUS IT WAS WITH GREAT SERIOUSNESS AND MONTHS OF THOUGHT THAT I DECIDED TO TRESPASS ON P.R.T.E., PROPERTY A.U.G., AND EQUAL SERIOUSNESS AND THOUGHT THAT I CHOSE TO SERVE THIS TIME IN jail RATHER THAN CURTAIL MY DUTY AS A CITIZEN TO PROTEST WHAT I SEE AS EXTREME DANGER TO THE PEOPLE OF THIS COUNTRY AND THE WORLD.

I AM SURE YOU HAVE AMPLE EXPERT TESTIMONY

AS TO THE DANGERS DIABLO CANYON POWER PLANT PRESENTS TO THE COMMUNITY OF SAN LUIS OBISPO AND THE STATE OF CALIFORNIA.

I BEG YOU TO HEAR THE TESTIMONY WITH OPEN MINDS AND HEARTS,, TO ACCEPT YOUR RESPONSIBILITY AS SERVANTS OF THE PEOPLE OF THIS GREAT COUNTRY, TO BE COURAGEOUS ENOUGH TO ACT FROM THE DEPTHS OF YOUR CONSCIENCE AS F, ONE HUMBLE CITIZEN, HAVE TRIED TO DO.

MY FAITH IN THIS COUNTRY AND HER IDEALS CONTINUES. MY FAITH IN HUMANITY IS STRONG.

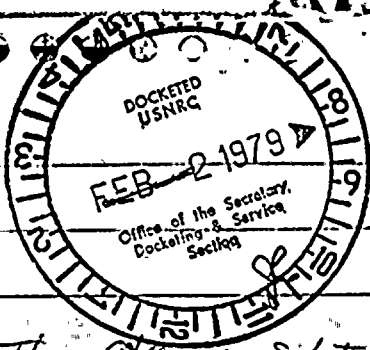

operate. I fully support the 487 people who were

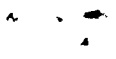
arrested ^{while} protesting the opening of this plant.
