Dear Brent:

Documents we have produced in response to your document requests have been available for some time in the "Discovery Room" (#629) at 215 Market Street and at the plant. Formal replies to these requests were made on May 4 and July 28, 1977, the latter indicating that the documents have been available since March 3 (geology and seismology) and May 23 (seismic design). Production of these documents involved a major effort on our part and considerable inconvenience to our engineers and others from whose files the documents were removed.

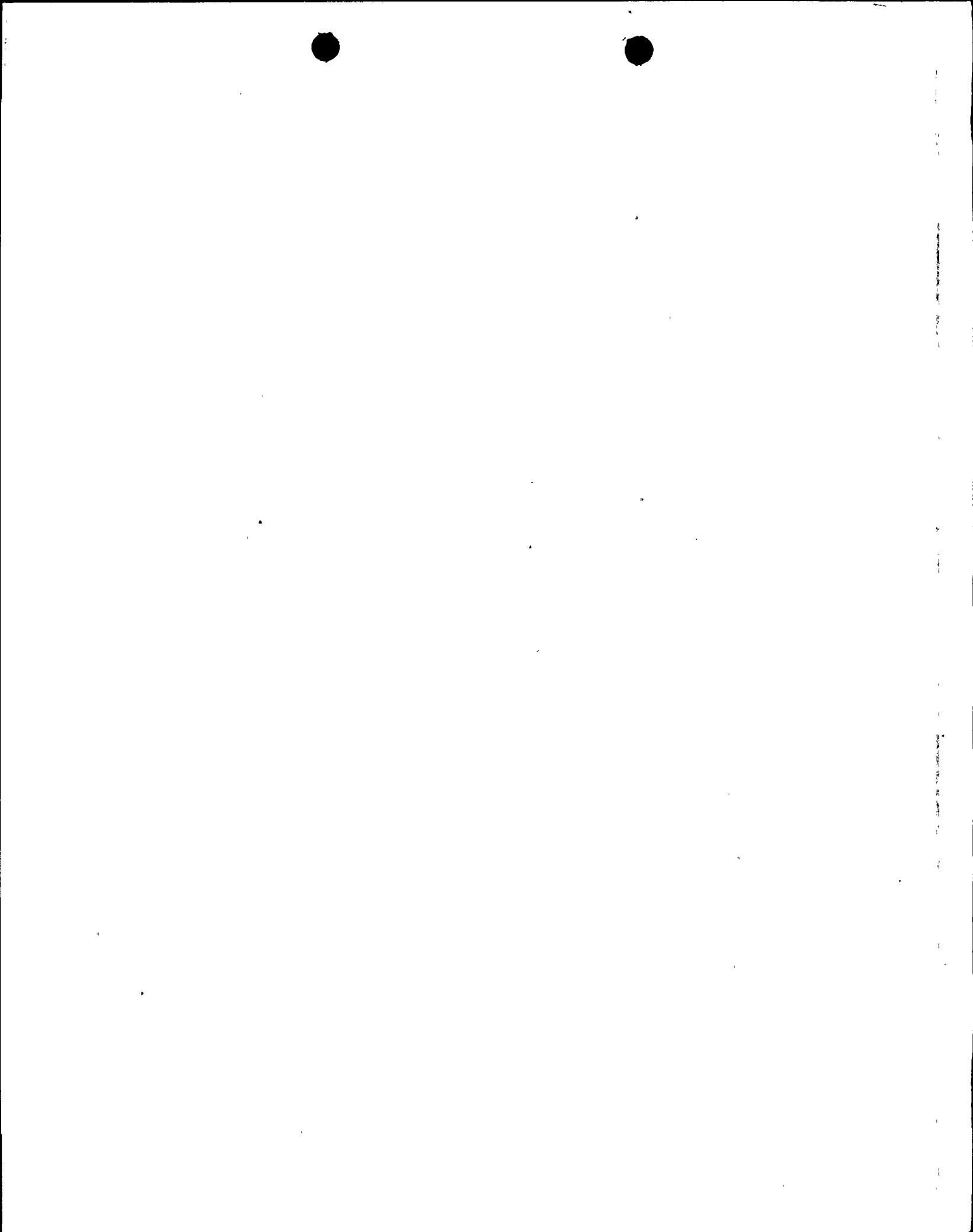
Meanwhile your consultants, MHB Associates, have been extraordinarily dilatory in examining these files. Since June 1 we have been favored with the presence of one or more of the three musketeers on June 2, 8, 23, 29, 30, July 13 and July 21. There have been no visits since July 21 and the documents are gathering dust. In the interim the PGandE engineers have not ceased importuning me for the return of their files.

Just as surely as we have a duty to respond to document requests within a reasonable amount of time you have the duty to have the documents examined by your consultants in a timely manner. In view of the prolonged nature of the process and the continuing inconvenience to our personnel I have asked those in charge of the discovery effort to return the engineers' files on October 1, 1977 at which time discovery of the documents covered by the three document requests will be deemed completed.

INTERIM ORDER RELATIVE TO PGandE'S
"MOTION TO ADVANCE HEARING DATE"

On July 5, 1977, PGandE filed a "Motion to Advance Hearing Date" from October 18, 1977 to September 19, 1977 with this Board. The motion suggested interim dates beginning with "August 1, 1977 - last day for filing interrogatories". The motion was silent concerning the ACRS action on non-seismic safety issues, although the earlier schedule was premised on the ACRS consideration in August of non-seismic safety issues. On July 15, 1977, the NRC Staff supported the PGandE motion with no mention of the ACRS consideration of the non-seismic safety issues, although the earlier schedule suggested by the Staff was based on the August consideration of the issues by the ACRS. The Center for Law in the Public Interest opposed the motion on July 13, 1977 because of the upcoming consideration by ACRS, and the possible need for CLPI to factor the ACRS action into their interrogatories to the Staff and Applicant.

The Staff is hereby directed to inform the Board and the parties as soon as possible the date(s) the ACRS will consider the non-seismic safety issues; when it will issue its report and when the Staff will issue a supplement to the SER based on that report.
