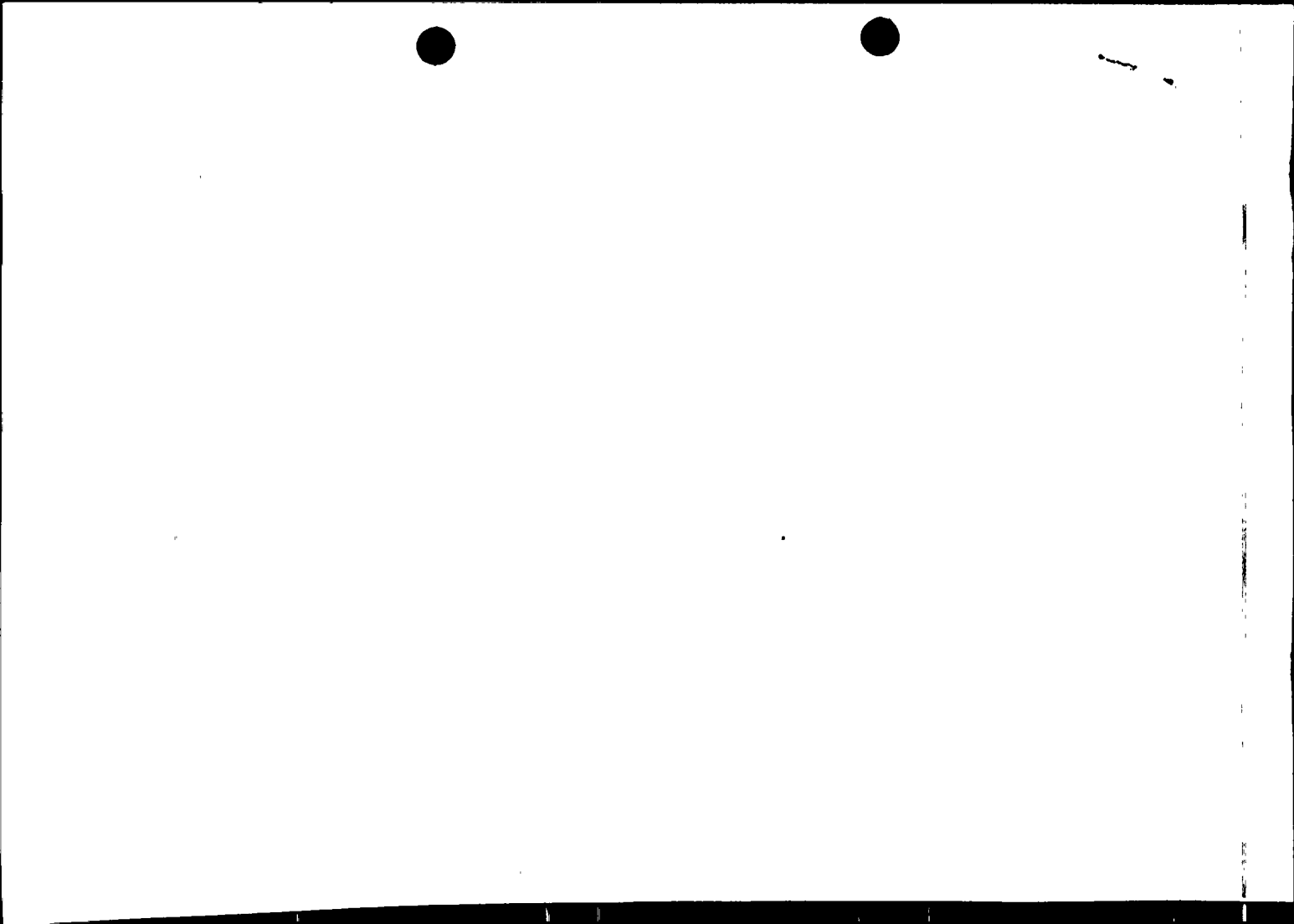



I will appreciate any information you may be able to provide.

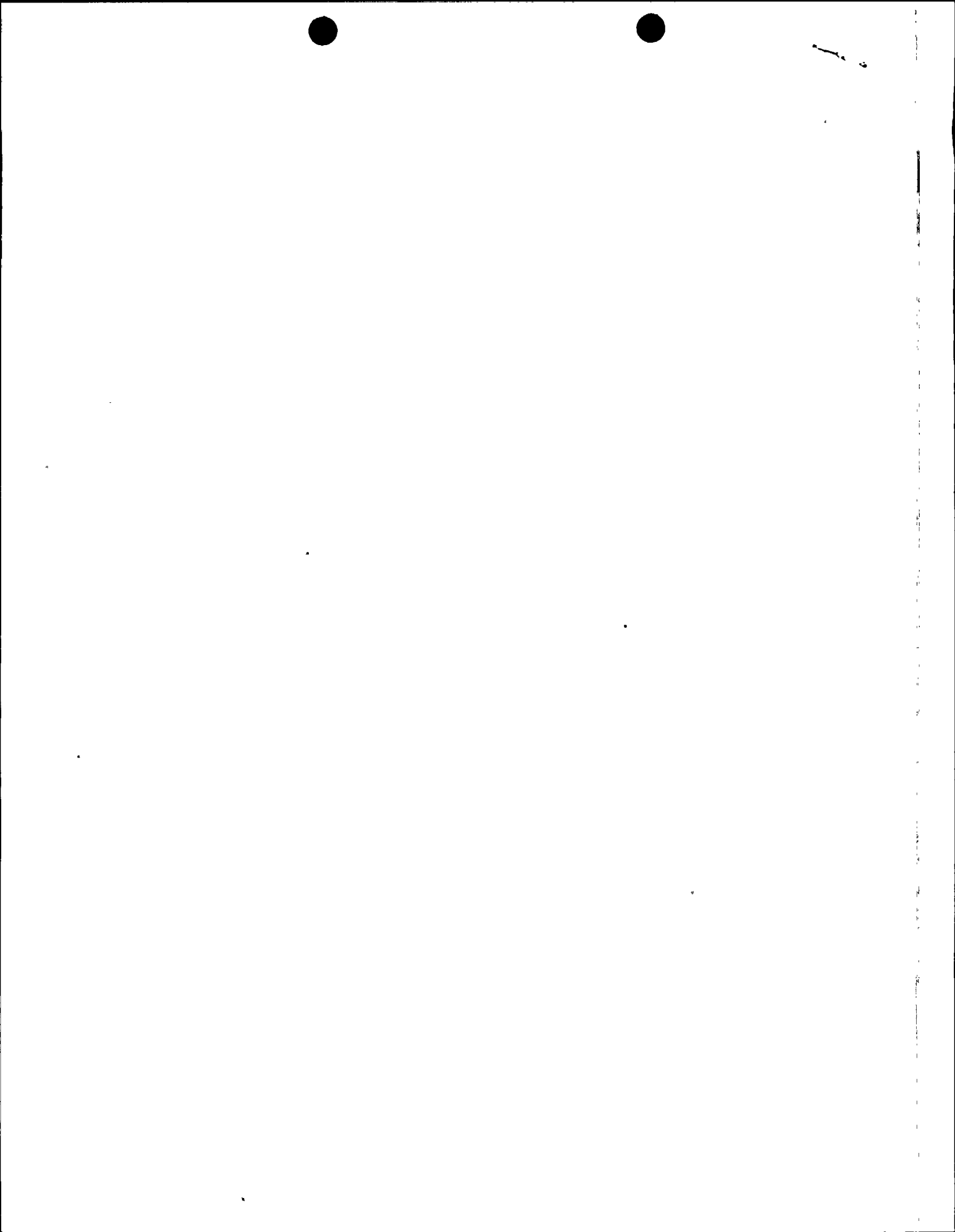

Dear Bob:

I appreciate your response on the Diablo Canyon Power Plant.

In your letter you indicate that Mr Ben Rushe, Director of Regulations for the Nuclear Power Commission, advised you that the Commission would have to work within the law of the statute before issuing any permits. We question the value of a law that requires nearly four years to compile adequate information and material to issue such a license.

P G & E has requested an interim permit to get the plant in operation to meet expected power demands. We feel that such a permit should be issued immediately on a temporary basis. A permit will prevent energy shortages and allow an initial test period of the plant.
