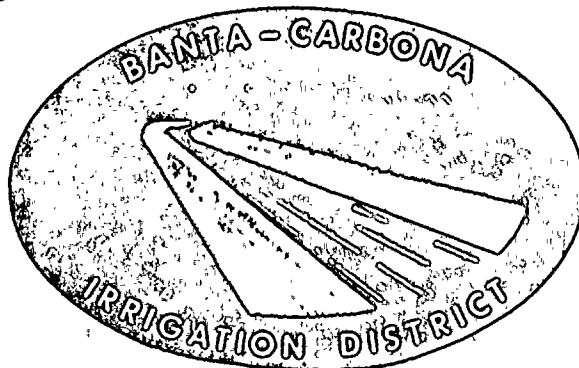

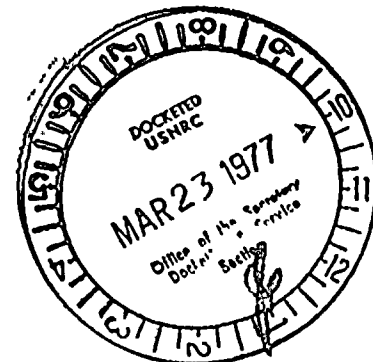

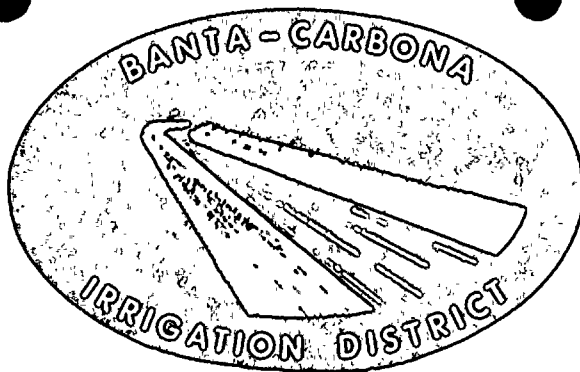

RESOLUTION

March 9, 1977

WHEREAS, California agricultural and domestic power needs are becoming more critical during one of the driest water years of record; and

WHEREAS, precipitation to date 1977 may prove to be an all time low; and

WHEREAS, because of the drought conditions, agriculture will have to rely on groundwater pumping to meet water needs; and

WHEREAS, groundwater pumping and many surface delivery systems require large quantities of electrical energy; and

WHEREAS, Pacific Gas & Electric Company's Diablo Canyon Nuclear Power Plant Unit 1 is complete and ready to begin operation; and

WHEREAS, in the absence of sufficient energy, agricultural water will be severely reduced and major crop losses will result,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED: That the Banta Carbona Irrigation District strongly urge the Nuclear Regulatory Commission to expedite the granting of an operating license to the Diablo Canyon Power Plant Unit 1.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED: That a copy of this Resolution be sent to the following with the request that they assist in getting the Diablo Canyon Plant into production.
