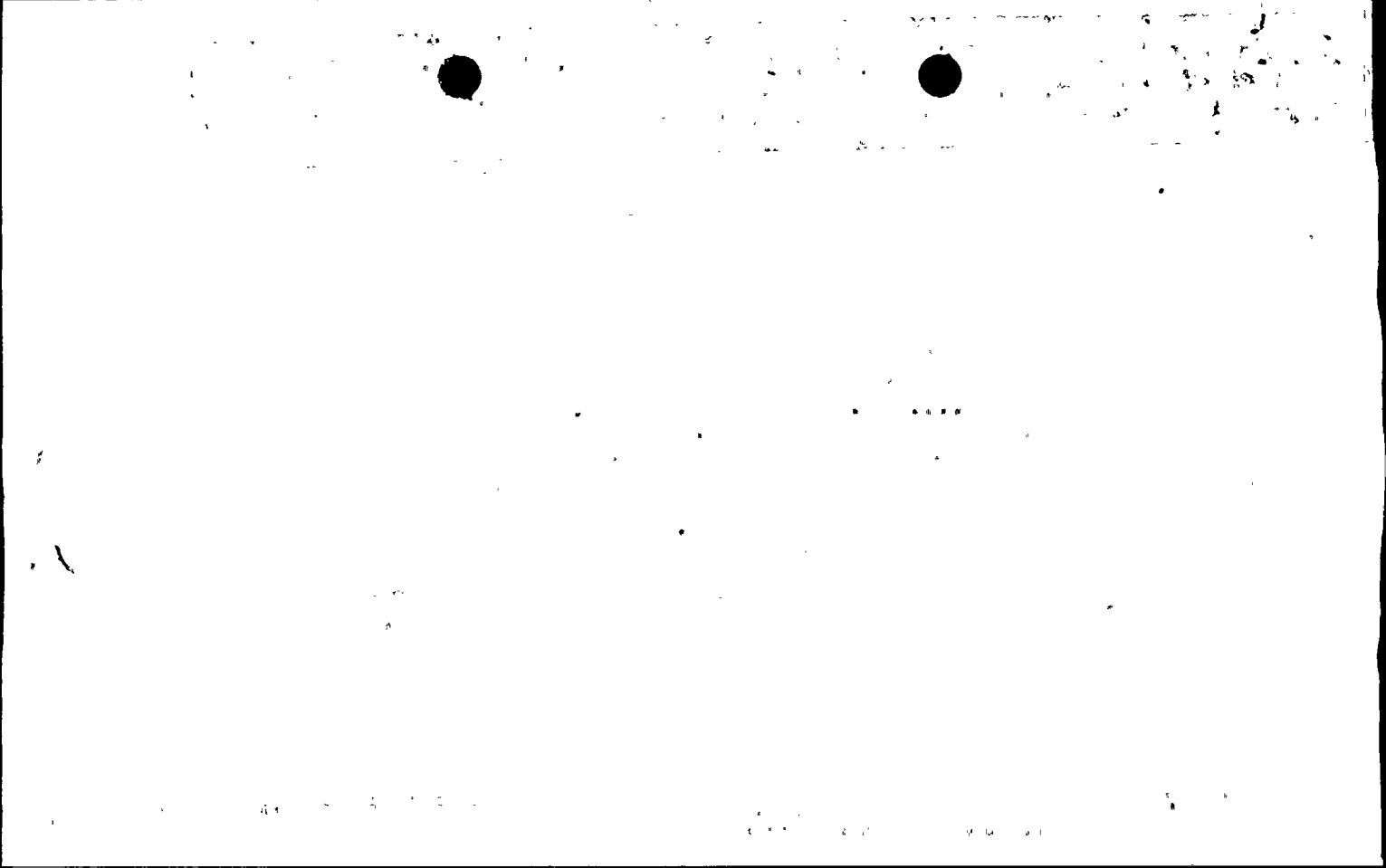

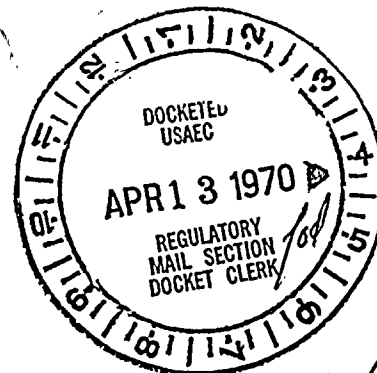
Dear Mr. Price:

P G and E is about to commence excavation for the containment structure, auxiliary building and turbine-generator building for Unit 2 at its Diablo Canyon site, as well as construction of a portion of the Unit 2 circulating water discharge conduit. This work quite clearly does not constitute "construction" within the meaning of 10 CFR 50.10 so a construction permit is not a necessary condition precedent thereto. We are advising you of the commencement of this work solely for the information of the Commission.
