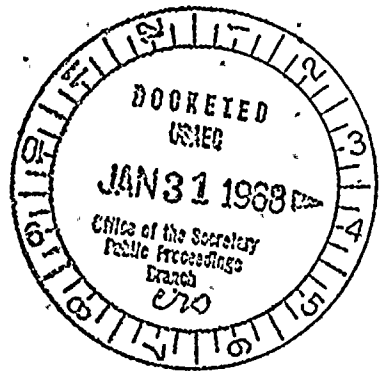

PETITION FOR LEAVE TO INTERVENE

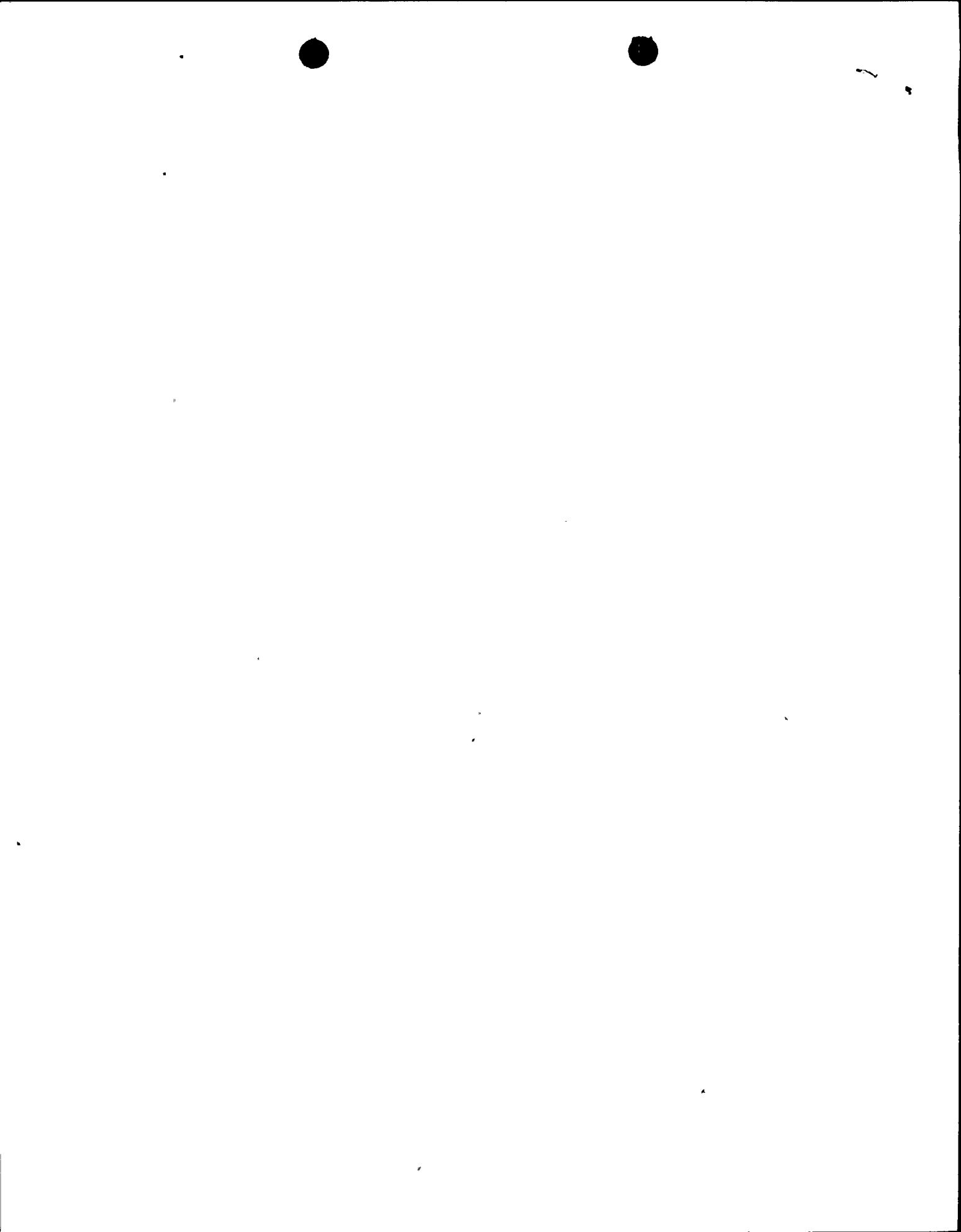
PURSUANT TO 10 CFR 2.714 LOCAL 1245 OF THE INTERNATIONAL BROTHERHOOD
