Dear Mr. Carstens:

This is in response to your letter of March 5, 1974, inquiring about the status of sites for nuclear power plants by San Diego Gas and Electric Company (SDG&E), Southern California Edison Company (SCE) and Pacific Gas and Electric Company (PG&E).

Southern California Edison proposes to build a two-unit high-temperature gas-cooled reactor designated as the Vidal Nuclear Generating Station, Units 1 and 2, in the eastern Mojave Desert area of southern California. We are presently reviewing pre-application geological and seismological information submitted by SCE. It is our understanding that SCE presently plans to submit to us later this year an application for a license to construct and operate this facility. It is also our understanding that SCE is contemplating a two-unit pressurized water reactor; however, we have no specific information regarding the proposed location of this facility.

Pacific Gas and Electric Company has not informed the Atomic Energy Commission of any plans for additional nuclear plants.
