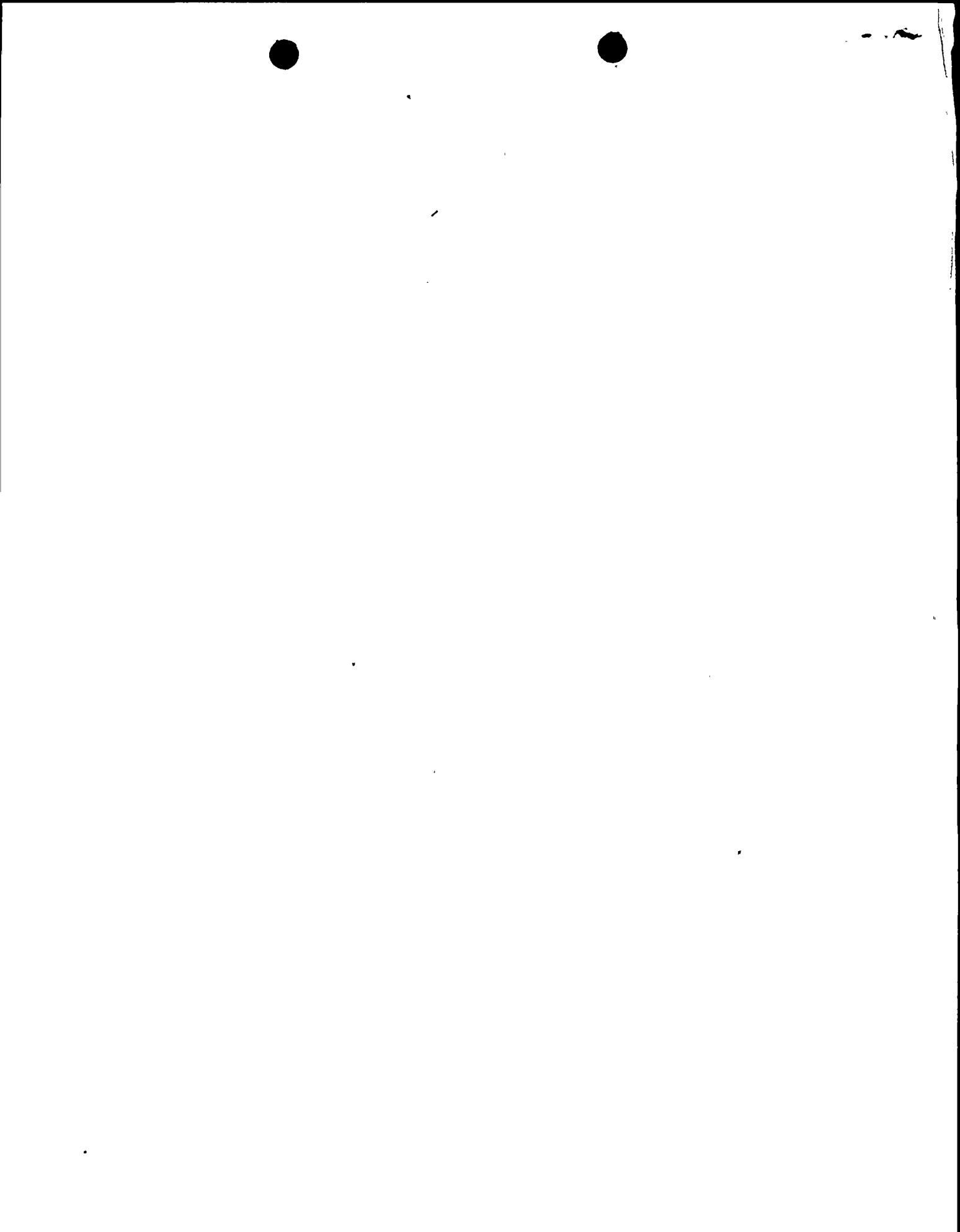

Dear Madame Chairman:

As a California resident I urge you to stop the mindless construction of the Diablo Canyon Atomic plant near San Luis Obispo immediately. It seems unconceivable that this plant is going up when you know the proximity to quake faults nearby. Sometimes bureaucratic decisions are simply stupid. Certainly this plant is in such a category - to put a plant in a dangerous area on our irreplaceable coastline is simply foolish. All such plants should be deep underground where if they fail they simply are destroyed in on themselves. Why the AEC and the power plants ignore this approach and generate all the dis-satisfaction and abuse is beyond me. Also San Onofre is no place for an A-plant. Get rid of it.
