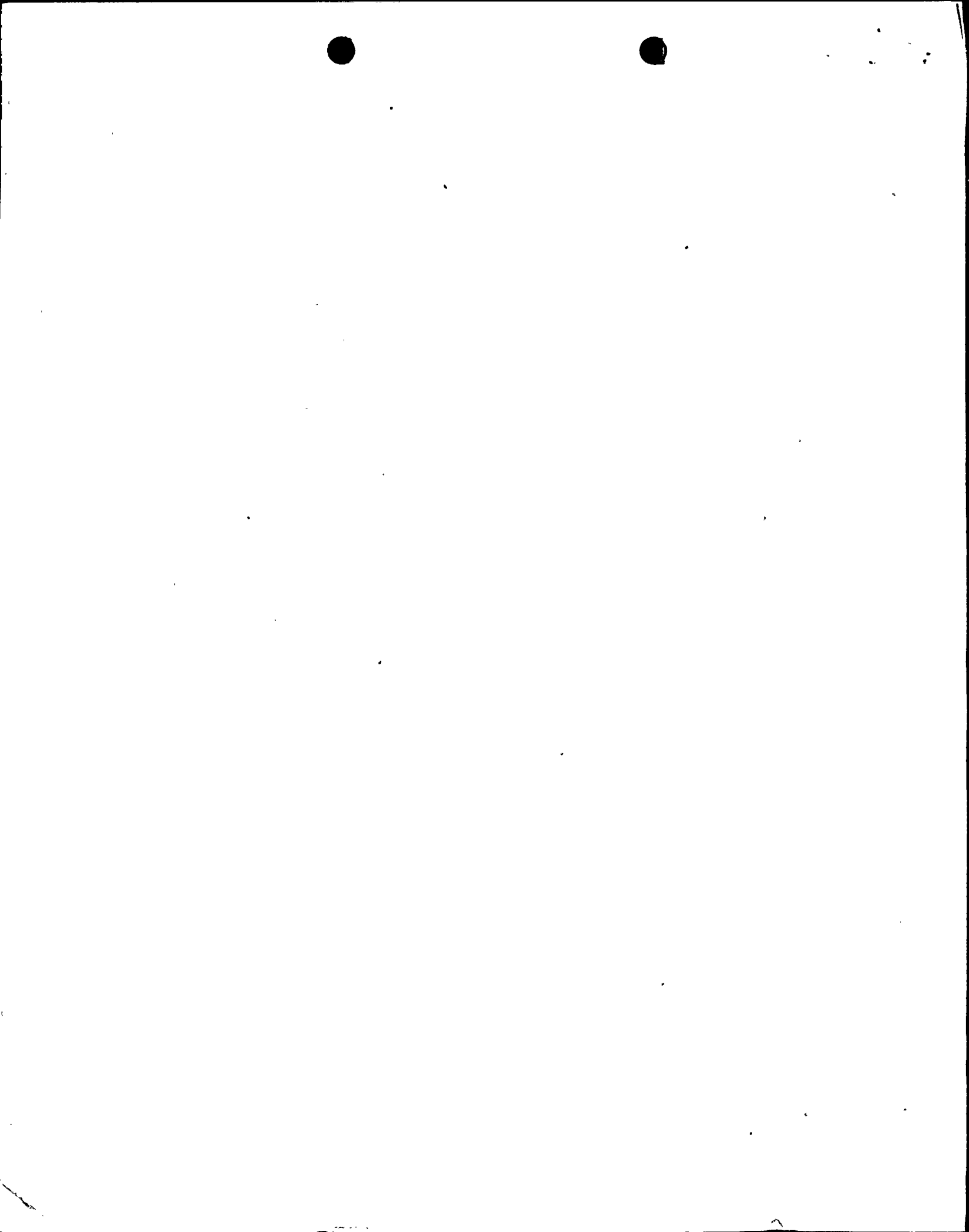

RESPONSE OF PACIFIC GAS AND ELECTRIC COMPANY
TO MOTION OF SAN LUIS OBISPO MOTHERS FOR PEACE
FOR FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE

In a motion dated June 10, 1975 the San Luis Obispo Mothers For Peace requested financial assistance from the ASLB or NRC. The question of financial assistance for intervenors is to be the subject of a public NRC rulemaking proceeding. In addition, the Atomic Energy Commission has ruled that pending the outcome of the rulemaking proceeding requests for financial assistance should be made following entry of a final agency order (In the Matter of Consumers Power Company (Big Rock Point Nuclear Plant), In the Matter of Vermont Yankee Nuclear Power Corporation (Vermont Yankee Nuclear Power Station), In the Matter of Public Service Co. of New Hampshire (Seabrook Station, Units 1 and 2), CLI 74-42, RAI 74-11, 820 (November 20, 1974)).

On both accounts the MFP motion is, therefore, premature



and should be denied.

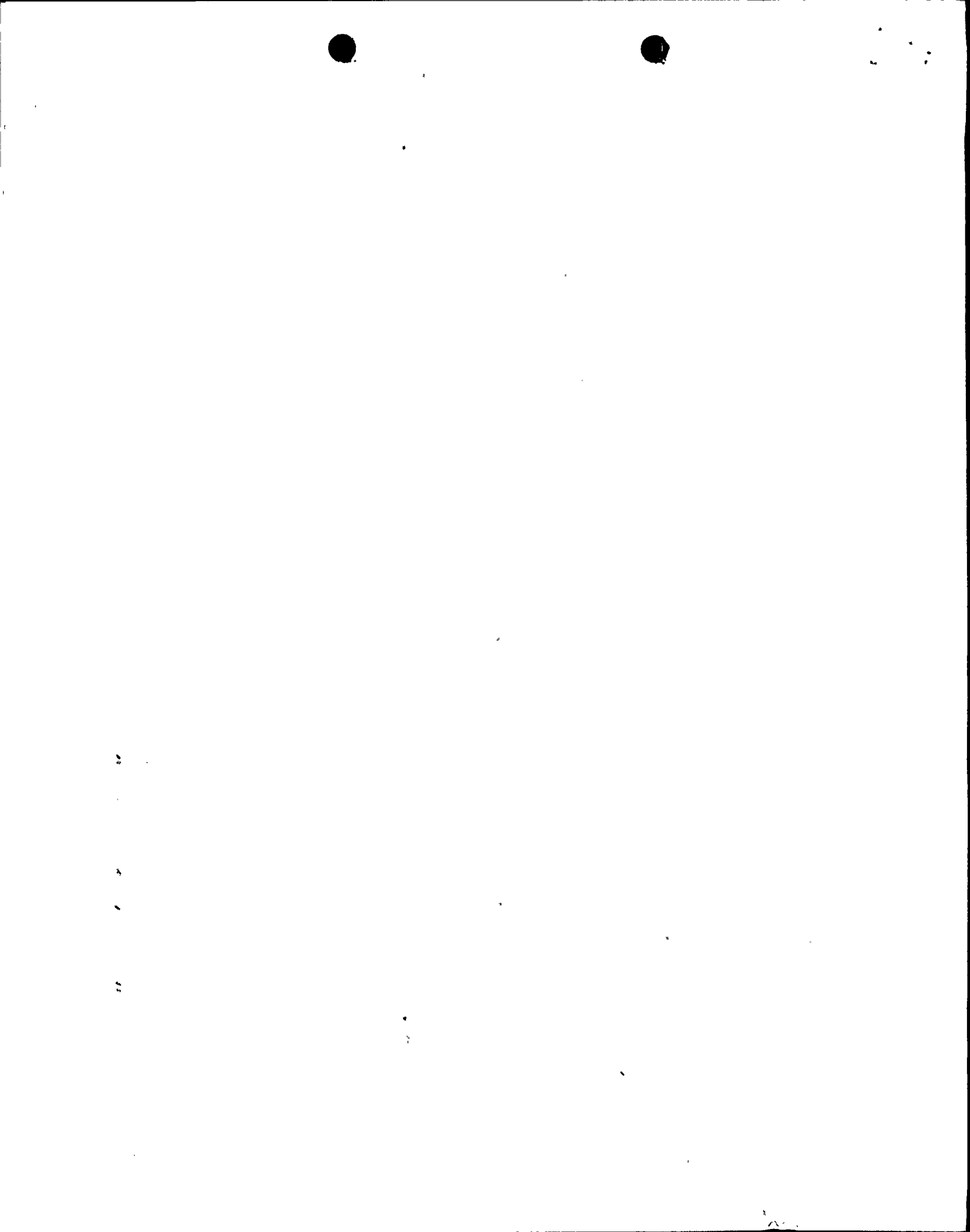

INC. FOR GEOLOGICAL-SEISMOLOGICAL DATA

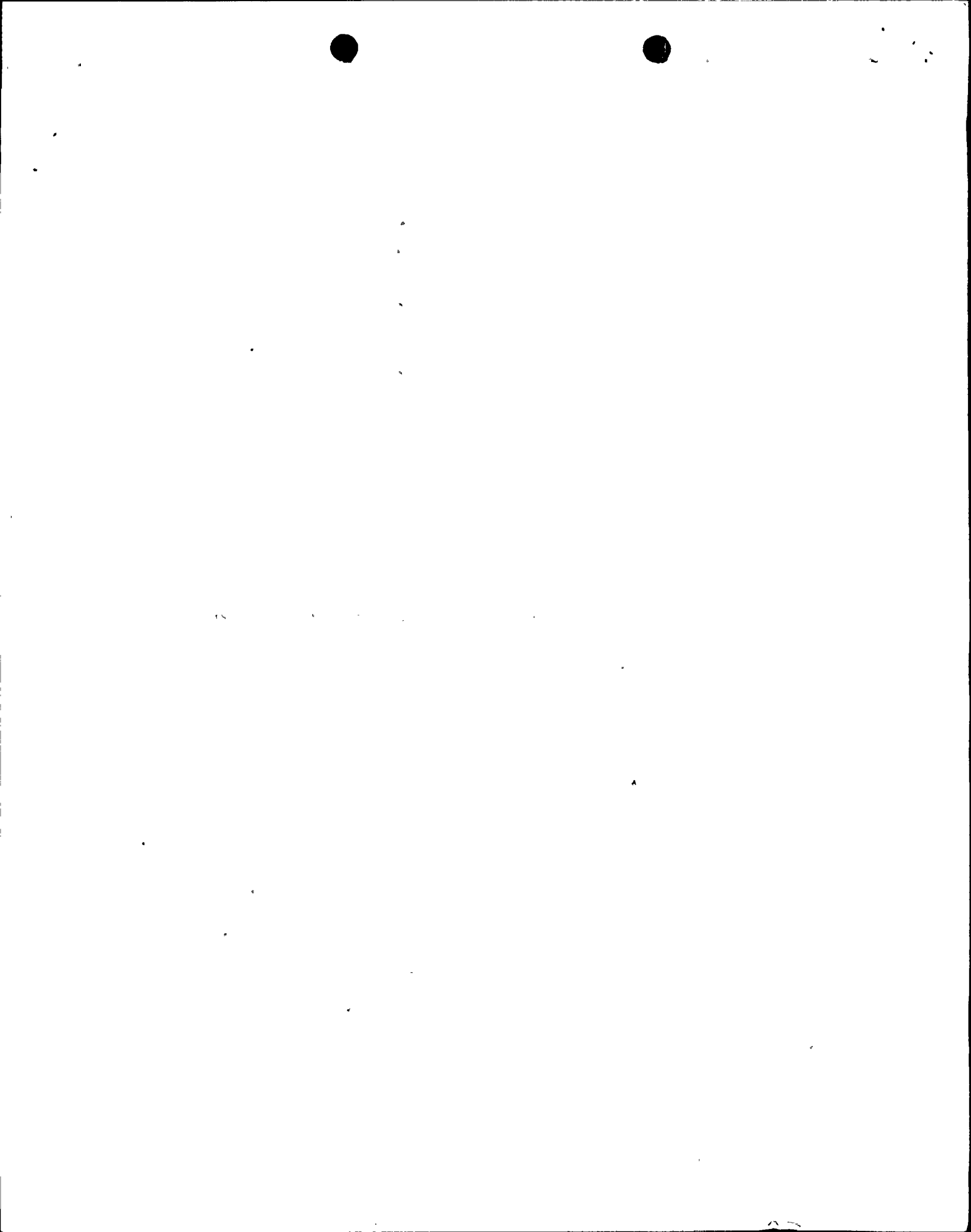
In a document dated June 8, 1975 Scenic Shoreline Preserva-
tion Conference, Inc. requested copies

" . . . of whatever reports are being relied upon and used as background reference by the United States Geological Survey, Staff, and Applicant in the current research and analysis of the geology and seismology affecting the Diablo Canyon nuclear power plants."

The reports relied upon by PGandE are, with two exceptions, contained or referred to in § 2.5 of the Final Safety Analysis Report. The references are listed beginning at page 2.5D-67 and primarily consist of documents which are generally available. PGandE can make available for inspection and copying at its offices or at the offices of its consultants the documents not generally available.



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
