June 14:

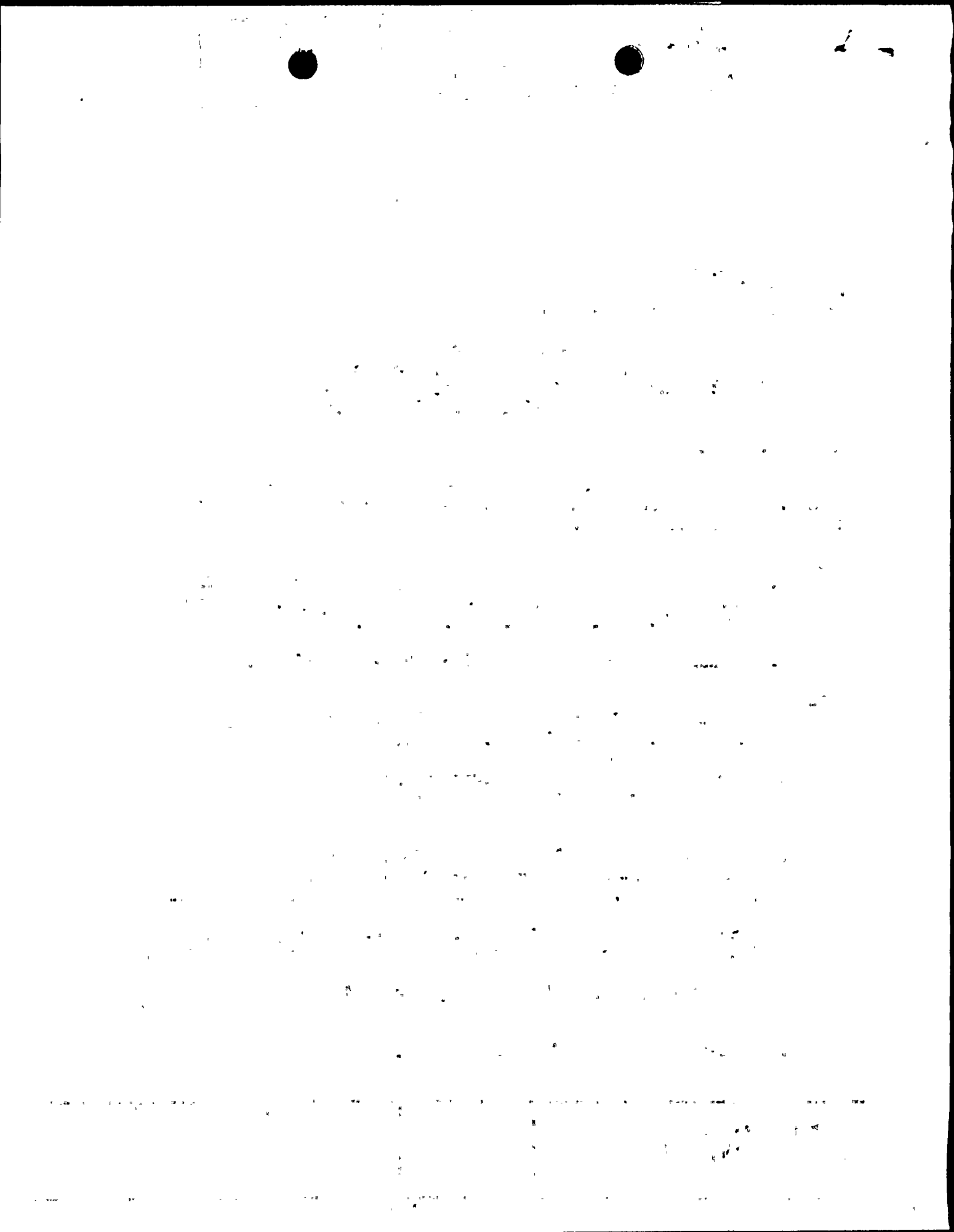
